POLICE EXECUTIVE SERVICE ELIGIBILITY (PESE) WRITTEN EXAMINATION ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Police Commission announces the conduct of the **14th POLICE EXECUTIVE SERVICE ELIGIBILITY (PESE) EXAMINATION** for all qualified uniformed members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) with the rank of Police Lieutenant Colonel (PLTCOL) and up, with permanent status of appointment.

The PESE Examination has two (2) phases – **PHASE I is the WRITTEN EXAMINATION** to be conducted on **SEPTEMBER 12, 2021 in Quezon City, Cebu City and Davao City**. **PHASE II is the VALIDATION INTERVIEW** for those who passed the Written Examination, the schedule of which shall be announced after the release of the results of the Written Examination.

Successful examinees in the Validation Interview shall be conferred the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE), the eligibility requirement for promotion to the third level ranks of Police Colonel, Police Brigadier General, Police Major General, Police Lieutenant General and Police General in the PNP.

I. PERIOD OF FILING : JULY 12 – AUGUST 13, 2021

II. DATE OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION : SEPTEMBER 12, 2021

III. EXAMINATION CENTERS

1. Quezon City – Camp Crame, PNP Training Service Building;
2. Cebu City – University of Cebu, Banilad Campus; and
3. Davao City – Davao Doctors' College.

IV. SCOPE AND COVERAGE

The written examination covers six (6) categories, as follows:

1. Job Knowledge
2. Leadership Competency
3. Communication Skills
4. Analytical / Logical Reasoning
5. Values
6. Emotional Quotient

V. WHERE TO GET APPLICATION FORMS

Application Form (Written Examination Form) and Index Card can be obtained for **FREE** at the NAPOLCOM Central Office located at DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, EDSA corner Quezon Avenue, West Triangle, Quezon City, or **at any NAPOLCOM Regional Office nationwide**. These may be **REPRODUCED** using the original copy and size of the application form and index card. Also, application forms may be downloaded from the NAPOLCOM website: www.napolcom.gov.ph

VI. WHERE TO FILE

An applicant must file his/her application form in any of the seventeen (17) NAPOLCOM Regional Offices indicating his/her choice of examination center, i.e., Quezon City (Luzon), Cebu City (Visayas) or Davao City (Mindanao).

VII. WHAT TO FILE

An applicant **must PERSONALLY, COMPLETELY and CORRECTLY** fill out the Application Form and Index Card and submit the following required documents to avoid delay in the release of his/her test result.

1. Properly accomplished Examination Application form (Written Examination Form) and Index Card;
2. Examination fee of ₱700.00;
3. One (1) piece latest I.D. photo (1 x 1 size) and two (2) latest identical I.D. photos (*passport size*), with full name tag that includes the First Name, Middle Initial and Surname, taken within three (3) months before the date of filing of the application. Pictures that are scanned, photo copied or computer enhanced are not accepted;
4. Two (2) legal size window envelopes with Twenty-One pesos (₱21.00) worth of **Mailing Stamp** affixed on each envelope; and
5. Copy of attested appointment (KSS Porma Blg. 33).

VIII. HOW TO FILE

Applications may be filed together with all the required supporting documents, **personally or by mail**, at any of the 17 NAPOLCOM Regional Offices **on or before the deadline for filing. AN APPLICANT MUST FILE ONLY ONE (1) APPLICATION.**

IX. NOTIFICATION OF WRITTEN EXAMINATION

A qualified applicant will be notified through a **Notice of Admission**. In case an applicant fails to receive such notice within five (5) days before the date of examination, he/she may verify the status of his/her application at the NAPOLCOM Office where his/her application was filed or at the NAPOLCOM Central Office with telephone nos. (02) 88990085 and (02) 84032588.

X. DRESS CODE

During the examination day, applicants (*Male and Female*) must be in **CORPORATE ATTIRE.**

XI. WHAT TO BRING DURING THE EXAMINATION

Examinees will bring the following:

1. Notice of Admission
2. Valid Identification (ID) card with picture
3. Lead Pencil No. 2
4. Black or Blue ball pen
5. One (1) passport size photograph
6. A Medical Certificate issued by a licensed government physician from the Barangay/Municipal/City/Provincial Health Office, or other government health monitoring center/office where the examinees reside. It must be clearly stated that the examinee is COVID-19 free and must be issued within seventy-two (72) hours before the examination day (*Medical Certificate issued by private health institution shall not be accepted*).

XII. NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS OF PHASE I – WRITTEN EXAMINATION:

Examinees shall be notified of the result of Phase I – Written Examination by mail. However, personal verification shall also be entertained. Examinees who successfully pass Phase I shall be qualified to undergo PHASE II – Validation Interview. The date, time and place of interview shall be announced later.

• **IMPORTANT REMINDERS** •

- The examination results of examinees involved in **acts of cheating** such as, but not limited to the following, shall be invalidated:
 - a. Impersonation;
 - b. Use of codigo or crib sheets;
 - c. Tampering with exam records;
 - d. Collusion of whatever nature between examinees and examination personnel;
 - e. Examination number switching;
 - f. Such other acts of similar nature that facilitate in passing the examination; and
 - g. Results declared by the Commission, thru its Examining Division, PAS, as statistically improbable.

The aforesaid examinees shall be **permanently barred** from taking the NAPOLCOM Examinations.

- Police service eligibility obtained through anomalous practices shall be **nullified**. (*NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2013-007, dated October 30, 2013*)

XIII. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

• **IMPORTANT** •

All examinees, whether passed or failed, shall be notified of the final result of the examination.

Those who successfully pass both the written examination and the validation interview shall be conferred the Police Executive Service Eligibility by the Commission in an appropriate ceremony.

NOTE: Applicable fees may be collected from those who will pass the Validation Interview for the Conferment Rites.
