RESOLUTION NO. 2015-057

PREScribing THE MINIMUM STANDARDS IN THE SPECIFICATIONS
FOR POCKET WIFI LONG TERM EVOLUTION (LTE)

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the PNP, through its PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2014-048 dated 18 July 2014, has recommended to the Commission the approval of the proposed standard specifications for Pocket Wifi Long Term Evolution (LTE);

WHEREAS, the PNP seeks to acquire the said gadget as intended for the PNP modernization program, and in response to the requirements of the PNP Public Information Office (PIO) for a ready wireless internet source use in the Asia Pacific Economic Conference (APEC);

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB certified the proposed specifications for Pocket Wifi Long Term Evolution (LTE) are not a tailored fit to any particular brand of product available in the open market, hence, is found in conformity with Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its constitutional power to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES the minimum standards in the specifications for Pocket Wifi Long Term Evolution (LTE), to read, as follows:

IV. Must pass the approved Test Parameters by the Chief, PNP duly publicized and/or included in the Terms of Reference of the Bidding Documents

RESOLVED FURTHER, that this Resolution shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from date of filing of a copy hereof at the University of the Philippines Law Center, pursuant to Executive Order No. 292 or otherwise known as the Administrative Code of 1987, as amended.


