RESOLUTION NO. 2015-157

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARD IN THE SPECIFICATIONS FOR HANDHELD
SATELLITE PHONE FOR THE USE OF PNP SPECIAL ACTION FORCE**

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP, through its PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2014-056 dated 18 July 2014, had recommended to the Commission for the approval of the proposed minimum standard in the specifications for handheld satellite phone;

WHEREAS, the Handheld Satellite Phone was designed to operate explicitly in remote areas where telephone landlines, cellular phones and radio transceiver system operationally incapable. This device will provide the PNP with enhanced communications equipment attuned to fast developing technology needed in times of disaster, natural calamities, fighting against criminalities and other activities where the needs are deemed necessary.

WHEREAS, the existing approved NAPOLCOM specifications for Handheld Satellite Phone is premised on the findings that said specifications is no longer responsive with the PNP’s present needs;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVED** the minimum standard in the specifications for Handheld Satellite Phone, to read as follows:
