RESOLUTION NO. 2015-547

APPROVING THE CREATION OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE  
ANTI-ILLEGAL DRUGS GROUP AS A NATIONAL OPERATIONAL SUPPORT UNIT

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Section 14 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, provides that the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) shall exercise administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, Section 35, RA 6975 provides that the PNP shall be supported by administrative and operational support units that includes the Narcotics Unit;

WHEREAS, Section 35 (b)(6), RA 6975 further states that the Narcotics Unit then of the PNP was organized primarily to "enforce all laws relative to the protection of the citizenry against dangerous and other prohibited drugs and substances;

WHEREAS, in line with the creation of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) under Section 82, RA 9165, otherwise known as the "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002" which states that the PDEA "shall be responsible for the efficient and effective law enforcement of all the provisions on any dangerous drug and/or controlled precursor and essential chemical as provided in this Act", the Narcotics Unit of PNP ceased to exist;

WHEREAS, the abolition of the Narcotics Group of the PNP is expressly provided under Section 86, RA 9165 which explicitly provides as follows:

*Section 86. Transfer, Absorption, and Integration of All Operating Units on Illegal Drugs into the PDEA and Transitory Provisions. – The Narcotics Group of the PNP, the Narcotics Division of the NBI and the Customs Narcotics Interdiction Unit are hereby abolished; x x x." (emphasis ours)*

WHEREAS, the Hon. Leila M. De Lima, Secretary, Department of Justice (DOJ), in its letter to then PDG Alan La Madrid Purisima, Chief, PNP, dated July 29, 2014, opined that "nothing in RA 9165 that prohibits the PNP from setting up a permanent Narcotics Investigation and Monitoring Center (NIMC), so long as it complies with the provisions of RA 9165 on the relationship of this PNP unit to the PDEA";

WHEREAS, in view thereof, the creation of the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Group (PNP AIDG) was proposed that shall be primarily responsible in the implementation of the anti-illegal drug strategy of the PNP in support to the PDEA;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the proposal to create the PNP AIDG to be in order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional and statutory mandates, HEREBY RESOLVES TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the creation of the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Group as a National Operational Support Unit (NOSU).

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP AIDG shall perform the following functions:

- a) Conduct all-out and sustained operations against drug syndicates and personalities in support of the programs and thrusts of the PDEA;
- b) Strengthen its operational capabilities to enhance the over-all anti-illegal drugs strategy of the PNP and intensify its campaigns against the production, processing, trafficking and retailing of illegal drugs;
- c) Maintain linkages with other law enforcement agencies and strengthen community participation in the fight against illegal drugs;
- d) Develop and maintain relevant database/s; and
- e) Perform other duties as directed by the Chief, PNP.

BE IT RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that the Command Group, staff and operating divisions and other units of the PNP AIDG shall comprise of the following:

#### Command Group

Director	- Police Senior Superintendent
Deputy Director for Administration	- Police Senior Superintendent
Deputy Director for Operations	- Police Senior Superintendent
Chief of Staff	- Police Senior Superintendent


#### Staff Divisions

Administrative and Resource Management Division	- Police Senior Superintendent
Intelligence and Foreign Liaison Division	- Police Senior Superintendent
Operations and Plans Division	- Police Senior Superintendent
Demand Reduction and Education Division	- Police Senior Superintendent
Legal and Investigation Division	- Police Senior Superintendent

The PNP AIDG shall maintain four (4) Special Operating Units and one (1) Special Weapons and Tactics Unit. Each unit shall be headed by a PCO with the rank of Police Superintendent. These units shall be provided with canine support by concerned PNP units.

BE IT RESOLVED FINALLY, that the other provisions of General Order Number DPL-14-14 and the organizational structure and staffing pattern as provided thereof, and in so far as it is not inconsistent with this Resolution, shall form part of this policy issuance.

**GENERAL ORDER  
NUMBER DPL-14-14**

**ACTIVATION OF UNIT**

1. Effective this date, the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Group with the official acronym "PNP-AIDG" is hereby activated as a National Operational Support Unit (NOSU) to serve as the primary unit responsible for the implementation of the anti-illegal drug strategy of the PNP, in a supporting role to the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA).

2. Consistent with the provisions of NHQ-PNP Circular No. DPL-03-02 dated October 26, 2003, entitled: "Specific Authority Delegated to the Directorial Staff", the Director for Operations (TDO) shall exercise functional authority over the PNP-AIDG. As such, TDO who is under the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations (TDCO) has the power to control specified processes, practices and other matters of the said Group.

3. The PNP-AIDG shall perform the following functions:

- a. Conduct all-out and sustained operations against drug syndicates and personalities in support of the programs and thrusts of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA);
- b. Strengthen its operational capabilities to enhance the over-all anti-illegal drugs strategy of the PNP and intensify its campaigns against the production, processing, trafficking and retailing of illegal drugs;
- c. Maintain linkages with other law enforcement agencies and strengthen community participation in the fight against illegal drugs;
- d. Develop and maintain relevant database/s; and
- e. Perform other duties as directed by the Chief, PNP.

4. The Command Group of the PNP-AIDG shall be composed of the following: (a) the Director, with the rank of Police Chief Superintendent (PCSUPT) and shall be considered as an entry position for a PCSUPT rank; (b) the Deputy Director for Administration and the Deputy Director for Operations, both with the rank of Police Senior Superintendent; and, (c) the Chief of Staff, with the rank of Police Senior Superintendent, who shall direct, supervise and manage the administrative affairs of the Group and facilitate coordination among the different Divisions and units of the PNP-AIDG.



5. The PNP-AIDG shall maintain five (5) staff divisions namely: (1) Administrative and Resource Management Division (ARMD); (2) Intelligence and Foreign Liaison Division (IFLD); (3) Operations and Plans Division (OPD); (4) Demand Reduction and Education Division (DRED); and, (5) Legal and Investigation Division (LID). Each Division shall be headed by a Police Commissioned Officer (PCO) with the rank of Police Senior Superintendent.

6. The Group shall maintain four (4) Special Operating Units and one (1) Special Weapons and Tactics Unit. Each unit shall be headed by a PCO with the rank of Police Superintendent. These units shall be provided with canine support by concerned PNP units.

7. The PNP-AIDG shall have a total personnel complement of 331; 65 of whom are Police Commissioned Officers (PCOs) with the ranks of Police Inspector to Police Chief Superintendent while 237 will be Police Non-Commissioned Officers (PNCOs) with the ranks of Police Officer 1 to Senior Police Officer IV; and 29 are Non-Uniformed Personnel (NUP). The Group shall absorb all NUP who were appointed to plantilla positions intended for the defunct PNP Narcotics Group.

8. When the situation demands for proactive or immediate operational support, the Director, PNP-AIDG shall exercise sound discretion and may realign, upgrade or downgrade the personnel complement of its Special Operations Units. Provided that, such measure shall not exceed the total authorized personnel complement of the Group.

9. Appropriate directives which will ensure a clearer delineation of functions and responsibilities of the Director, PNP-AIDG, other National Support Units and the Regional Directors of Police Regional Offices on anti-illegal drug campaign shall be formulated by the Directorate for Operations, subject to the approval of the Chief, PNP. Likewise, other detailed implementing directives necessary for the operationalization of the PNP-AIDG shall be issued by the Directorate for Operations.

10. In the interim, the Anti-Illegal Drugs Special Operations Task Force (AIDSOTF) which was established under the Office of the Chief, PNP shall continue to exist as a nucleus of the PNP-AIDG and shall perform its mandate under Executive Order No. 218, series of 2003. Its personnel, records, equipment, facilities, funds, and other resources shall be absorbed and transferred to the newly-activated PNP-AIDG.

11. The PNP AIDG shall occupy the current building and facilities being used by the AIDSOTF.

12. Requisite support pertaining to personnel, logistics, training, facilities, funds and other resources for the smooth implementation of this directive shall be provided by concerned PNP Directorial Staff, subject to existing policies and procedures as well as the approval of the Chief, PNP.

13. All directives and issuances in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

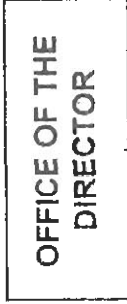

**Director, PNP-AIDG:**

1. Direct, supervise and control the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Group which shall include tactical and strategic movements, deployment and utilization of its resources for the accomplishment of the following tasks:
  - a. Conduct an all-out and sustained operations against drug syndicates and personalities in support of the programs and thrusts of the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA);
  - b. Strengthen its operational capabilities to enhance the over-all anti-illegal drugs strategy of the PNP and to intensify its campaigns against production, processing, trafficking and retailing of illegal drugs
  - c. Maintain linkages with other law enforcement agencies and strengthen community participation in the fight against illegal drug menace;
  - d. Develop and maintain the PNP-AIDG database; and
2. Perform other duties as directed by the Chief, PNP

**Deputy Director for Administration**

1. Assist the Director, PNP-AIDG in supervising, directing and coordinating the activities of the PNP-AIDG pertaining to its administrative and organization.
2. Advice and assist the Director PNP-AIDG in the execution of polices, directives, programs and projects.
3. Perform other duties as the second in command in the PNP-AIDG or act in the latter's absence.

**Deputy Director for Operations:**

1. Assist the Director, PNP-AIDG in supervising, directing and coordinating the operations of Group.
2. Advise and assist the Director, PNP-AIDG in the execution of polices, directives, programs and projects pertaining to operations.
3. Perform other duties as directed by the Director PNP-AIDG.

**Chief of Staff:**

1. Direct, supervise and manage the administrative affairs of the Group as well as facilitate coordination among the different Divisions and units of the PNP Anti-Illegal Drugs Group (PNP-AIDG).
2. Perform other duties as directed by the Director, PNP-AIDG

**ADMINISTRATIVE & RESOURCE MANAGEMENT DIVISION (ARMD)**

1. Advise the Director, PNP-AIDG on matters pertaining to personnel and service support.
2. Supervise, plan and coordinate the administrative activities and functions of the Group.
3. Formulate and implement plans and policies pertaining to personnel matters and other administrative requirements of the Group.
4. Translate decisions into directives concerning personnel management, morale and welfare of personnel, and discipline and order.
5. Identify problems and deficiencies and propose revisions on administrative system, policies and procedures.
6. Manage the recruitment and placement of personnel and other related activities.
7. Monitor and conduct performance evaluation of all PNP-AIDG personnel and submit necessary recommendations to Director, PNP-AIDG.
8. Administer the referrals and dispatch of all incoming and outgoing communications.
9. Responsible for the security, maintenance and cleanliness of PNP-AIDG building and its surroundings.
10. Prepare financial and logistical support proposals of PNP-AIDG.
11. Plan, coordinate and determine the logistical and financial requirements of PNP-AIDG.
12. Facilitate the necessary issuance of logistical requirements of PNP-AIDG.
13. Ensure maintenance and serviceability of all logistical equipment of PNP-AIDG.
14. Attend to financial related requirements of PNP-AIDG to higher office to include personnel claims and benefits.
15. Perform other tasks as directed.

**INTELLIGENCE & FOREIGN LIAISON DIVISION (IFLD)**

1. Plan, coordinate and supervise all intelligence activities of the Division.
2. Formulate policies and guidelines on intelligence and counter-intelligence operations of PNP-AIDG.
3. Act on intelligence requirements, task allocations and disseminate intelligence estimates as needed or as required.
4. Prepare intelligence estimates, watchlist, target list, list of most wanted drug traffickers and manufacturers and other special reports to include COPLANS against identified drug syndicates.
5. Coordinate with other PNP, AFP and other law enforcement units on matters of mutual concern.
6. Act as point of contact with foreign counterparts and other anti-illegal drug organizations.
7. Conduct background investigation/record check of personnel accommodated to PNP anti-illegal drugs units.
8. Conducts adjudication proceedings on PNP personnel with derogatory information and/or listed in CI watchlist on illegal drugs.
9. Conduct researches and prepare special studies of intelligence interest of the Group.

**OPERATIONS & PLANS DIVISION (OPD)**

1. Supervise the conduct of anti-illegal drugs operations of the Group.
2. Update the Director, AIDG on the progress of live illegal drug cases.
3. Prepare and issue appropriate operation plans, orders and directives.
4. Ensure submission of periodic reports to higher office to include statistical data of illegal drugs incidents.
5. Undertake lateral coordination with other PNP units and other law enforcement agencies for operational capability enhancement of the Group.
6. Develop and maintain the PNP-AIDG database.
7. Coordinate with other concerned divisions in the build-up of illegal drug cases and personalities.
8. Conduct research or studies on existing anti-illegal drugs laws and policies in coordination with other PNP Offices and recommend appropriate amendments when necessary.
9. Attend conferences as required and supervise the preparation of presentations, briefings, handouts when necessary.
10. Provide security to witnesses during court hearing, as necessary.
11. Supervise the preparation of press conference in coordination with PIO.
12. Perform other tasks as directed.

**B**

**DEMAND REDUCTION AND EDUCATION DIVISION (DRED)**

1. Implement the Demand Reduction Program of the PNP through the formulation and conduct of public information and education program.
2. Develop and implement public information and education campaign and advocacy programs in coordination with appropriate NGAs, NGOs and LGUs, to increase community awareness on the ill-effects of drugs.
3. Promote and implement drug abuse prevention and education programs in PNP workplaces.
4. Develop and institutionalize a uniform module/vehicle in the conduct of massive drug awareness activities.
5. Supervise the dissemination of information of all PNP activities and programs relative to the campaign against illegal drugs.
6. Act on drug-related reports from walk-in, phone-in complainants, referrals from other offices/agencies, etc. and refer the same to appropriate agencies/offices.
7. Monitor and conduct periodic assessment on the implementation of drug demand reduction strategy of field units.
8. Perform other tasks as directed.

**LEGAL & INVESTIGATION DIVISION (LID)**

1. Supervise and coordinate the investigation, indictment of drug suspects and the evidence gathering and filing of strong cases.
2. Formulate, implement, evaluate and update operating procedures on investigation of all forms of illegal drug cases/incidents.
3. Oversee the inventory and custody of seized drug and non-drug evidence prior to turn-over to PDEA.
4. Liaise with other financial investigative units for the conduct of financial investigation against drug syndicates.
5. Coordinate with PDEA, DDB, DOJ Court, other line units and judicial entities for legal offensive capability enhancement.
6. Recommend suspects/witnesses to avail the witness protection program.
7. Develop a system for effective monitoring of all drug cases investigated by PNP from investigation, prosecution and conviction phase.
8. Conduct studies and researches to upgrade the scientific investigative capability of the PNP-AIDG.
9. Recommend measures of laws to enhance the successful investigation and prosecution of production, processing, trafficking and retailing of illegal drugs in coordination with other offices concerned.
10. Perform other tasks as directed.

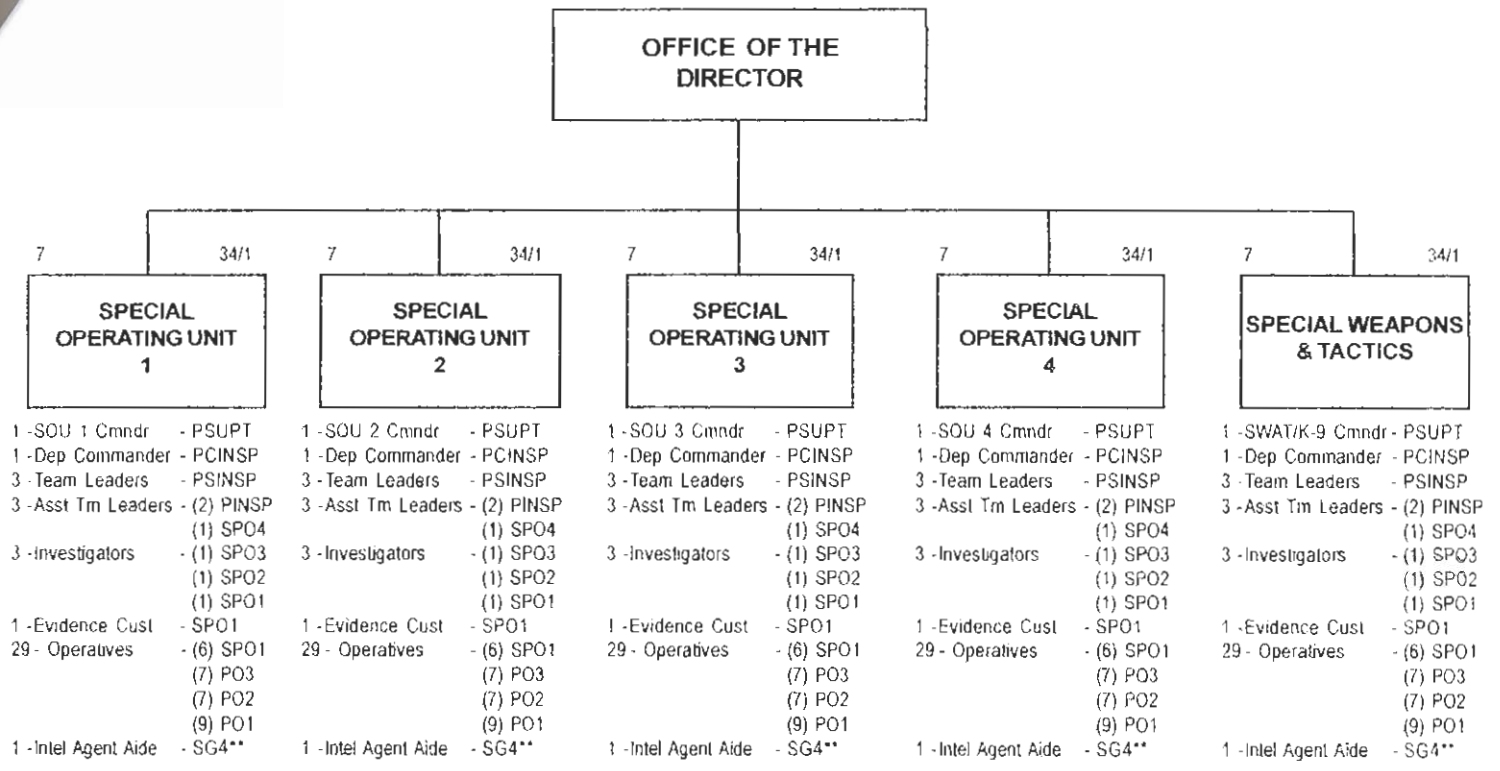
**AIDG SPECIAL OPERATING UNITS**

**SPECIAL WEAPONS AND TACTICS**

1. Act as the implementing arm of the Group on Supply Reduction Strategy.
  2. Prepare and implement appropriate operation plans, orders and directives.
  3. Conduct intensive operations focusing on international and local drug syndicates involved in importation, manufacturing and large scale trafficking of illegal drugs and Controlled Precursors & Essential Chemicals (CPECs).
  4. Conduct eradication of marijuana plantation and plant sources of illegal drugs.
  5. Coordinate with the concerned Divisions of the PNP-AIDG in the build-up of illegal drug cases and personalities.
  6. Responsible for the serving of warrants of arrest and conduct manhunt operations.
  7. Provide security to witnesses during court hearing, as necessary.
  8. Ensure prompt submission of periodic reports to higher office.
  9. Coordinate with other PNP, AFP and other law enforcement units, within its area of jurisdiction, on operational matters of mutual concern.
  - 10 Perform other tasks as directed by the Director PNP-AIDG
1. Prepare implementing plan based on directives from higher headquarters.
  2. Recommend and evaluate all organizational and operational activities of the unit.
  3. Undertake K9 operations in coordination with other AIDG Special Operating Units with the utilization of Explosive Detector Dogs, Narcotic Detector Dogs and Tracker Dogs to detect controlled/dangerous substances and locate suspects.
  4. Coordinate with the concerned Divisions of the PNP-AIDG in the build-up of illegal drug cases and personalities.
  5. Provide security to witnesses during court hearing, as necessary.
  6. Coordinate with other PNP, AFP and other law enforcement units, in the pursuit of the Units mission and on operational matters of mutual interest.
  7. Ensure prompt submission of periodic reports to higher office.
  8. Perform other tasks as directed by the Director PNP-AIDG.

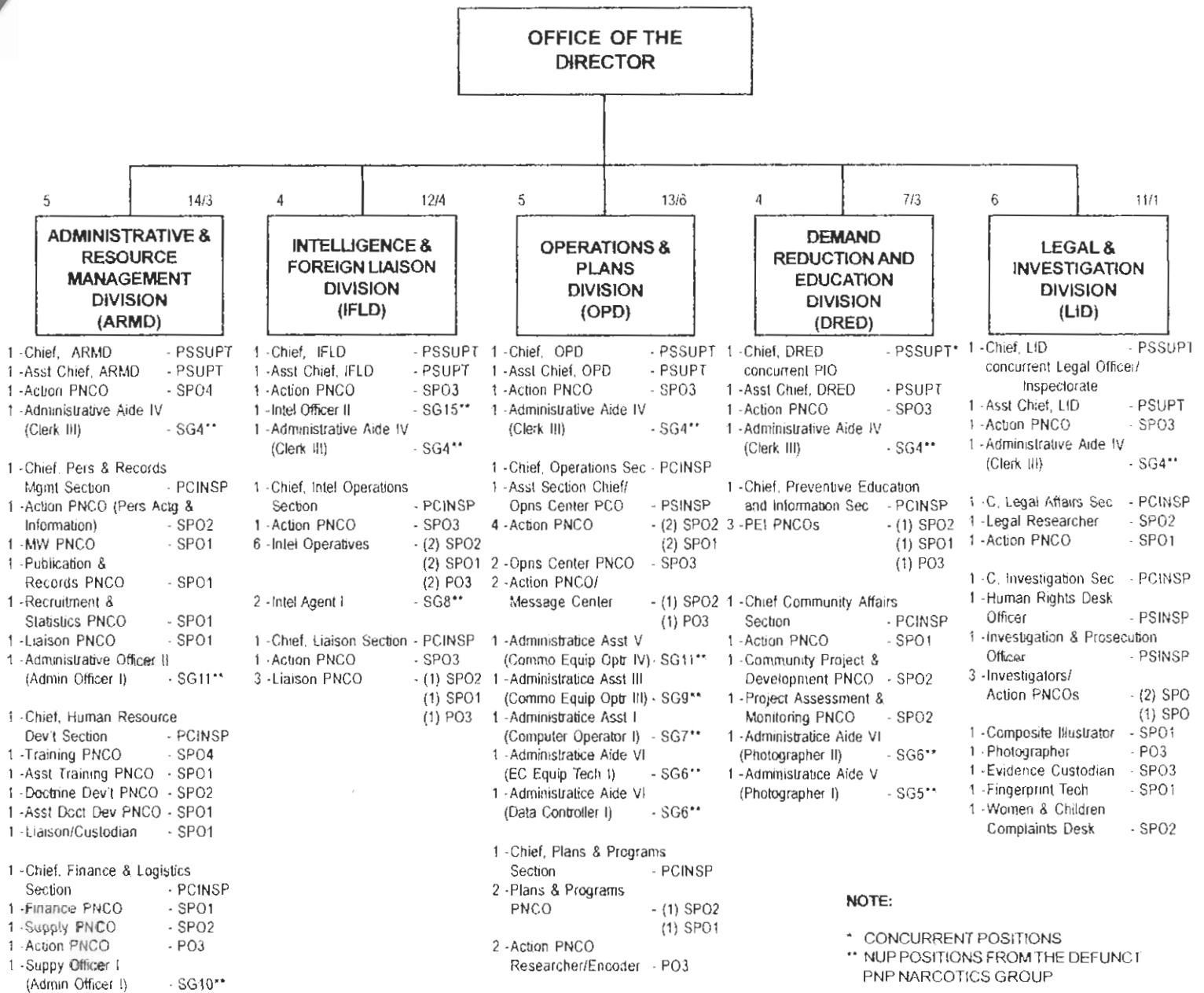

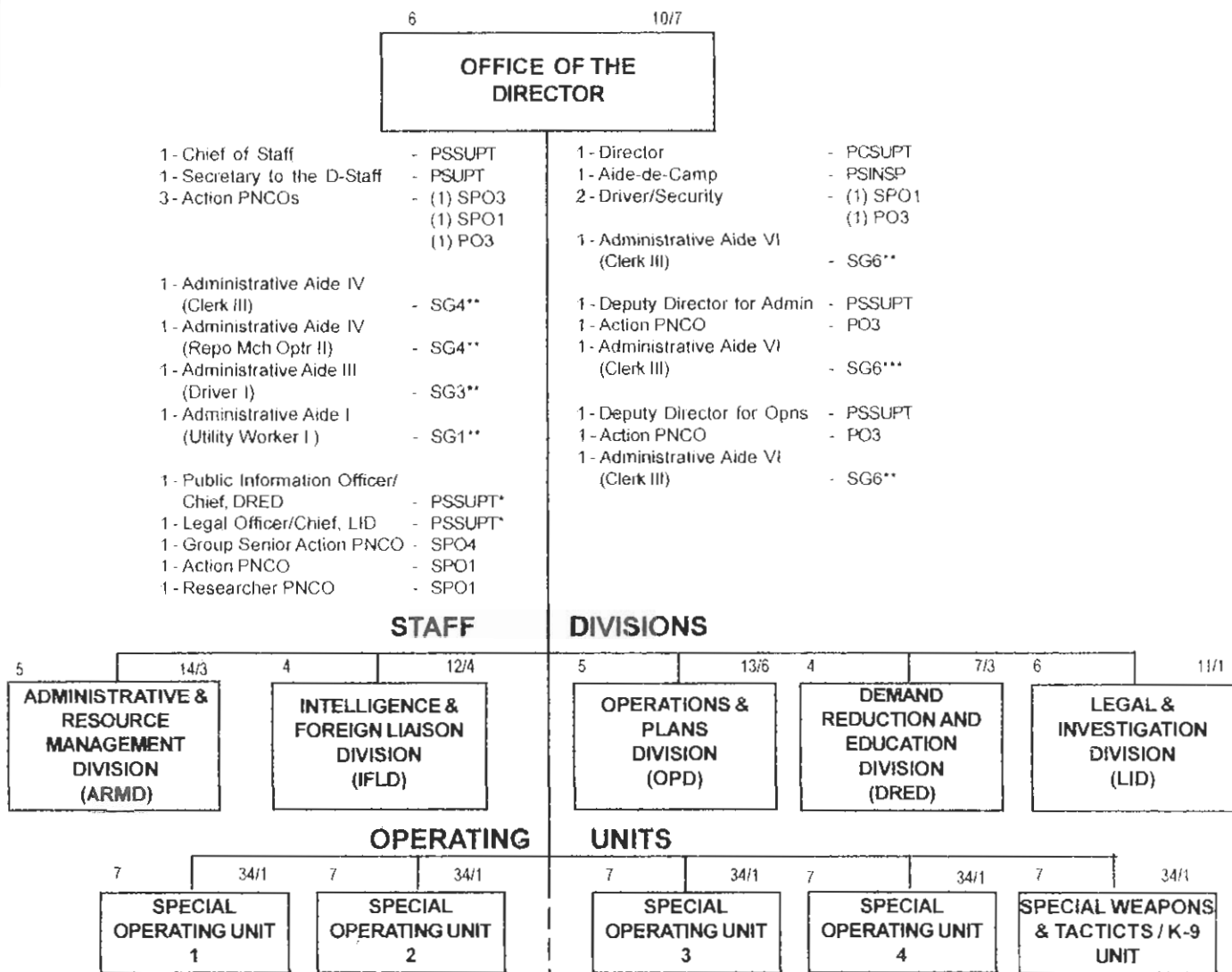
