RESOLUTION NO. 2015-552

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS SPECIFICATIONS  
FOR EOD RECOILLESS DE-ARMER AND DISRUPTOR

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, PNP, Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2014-081 dated 10 October 2014, recommended to the Commission the approval of the proposed amendment to the standard specifications for EOD Recoilless De-armer and Disruptor, as basis for procurement of the equipment for the use of PNP-Explosive and Ordnance Disposal;

WHEREAS, the PNP seeks to acquire an EOD tool which utilizes a range of solid, fluid, and frangible projectile that is released from a muzzle at a very high velocity without recoil such that the solid projectiles like steel slugs, chisels or forks neutralizes the fuze of Unexploded Ordnance (UXO), land service ammunition or hard-cased Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs), the disruptor on the other hand, releases high pressure fluid or frangible projectile to disable the firing circuit of IEDs;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB explained that though several item descriptions are wanting of data from known manufacturers'/suppliers' product brands, the proposed specifications for EOD Recoilless De-armer and Disruptor is certified as available and not a tailored fit specification to any particular brand of product available in the open market;

WHEREAS, the Commission has determined the proposed subject specifications conforms with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES to prescribe the minimum standard specifications for EOD Recoilless De-armer and Disruptor, with slight modifications for wider participation of interested manufacturer for the procurement procedure thereof, to read as follows:

- I. Function/Features ; The tool must have a dual function a De-Armer and/or Disruptor
- II. Technical Specifications
  - A) Mode of Operation : Recoilless
  - B) Shot : Multi-shot
  - C) De-armer Barrel Length : 20 inches (maximum)
  - D) Disruptor Barrel Length : 22 inches (maximum)


- E) Propelling Charge : Gauge 12 Ammunition
- F) Recoilless System : Annular Compensator System or Similar Assembly to Completely Eliminate Recoil
- G) Projectile (for De-armor) : 1) Chisel/Blade Slug  
2) Plain Slug  
3) Fork Slug
- H) Accessories : 1) 1 set loading/unloading tool set  
2) 1 set devices and consumables necessary for the operation of the equipment  
3) 1 set Tool/Cleaning Kit  
4) 1 set Lightweight Multi-Position Stand and Mounting Clamps  
5) 1 set Lightweight Plastic Protective/ Carrying Case  
6) Instructional Manual

III. Must pass the PNP Test and Evaluation
