RESOLUTION No. 2015-586

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
“PORTABLE RADAR LIFE DETECTOR”

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP through the Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2015-014 dated May 7, 2015 has favorably submitted for the consideration of the Commission the proposed minimum standard specifications for Portable Radar Life Detector;

WHEREAS, a Portable Radar Life Detector is a search and rescue device capable of locating or sensing movements of a trapped victim / survivor caused by both natural and man-made disaster such as collapsed building, landslide, etc.;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB certified that the proposed standard specifications for Portable Radar Life Detector is not tailored to any product brand of a manufacturer/supplier available in the market;

WHEREAS, upon careful review and evaluation of the records, the minimum standard specifications for Portable Radar Life Detector is found to be in order and in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) and all other existing policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES, to adopt and prescribe the minimum standards specifications for Portable Radar Life Detector with slight modifications, to read as follows:


