RESOLUTION NO. 2015-588

APPROVING THE CORRECTIONS IN THE SPECIFICATIONS ITEM DESCRIPTION
REQUIREMENT FOR MOUNTING SYSTEM PARAMETER UNDER NAPOLCOM
RESOLUTION NO. 2015-195 THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARDS IN THE
SPECIFICATIONS FOR REFLEX (OPTIC) SIGHT FOR RIFLE

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5 paragraph (a), sub paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor";

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 195 dated June 16, 2015 prescribed the minimum standards in the specification for Reflex (Optic) Sight for Rifle for use by the PNP Special Action Force Group (SAFG) during Internal Security Operations;

WHEREAS, P/Dir. Catalina B. Rodriguez, Director for Research and Development (DRD), in its letter dated July 15, 2015 requested the Commission to consider corrections be made in the typographical error indicated in NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2015-195 which prescribe the minimum standard in the specifications for Reflex (Optic) Sight for Rifle;

WHEREAS, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2014-045 dated August 15, 2014 and the IIS Summary Disposition Form (SDF) showed the item description for mounting system is "MIL-STD 1913" but unfortunately instead showed "MIL-STD 1013" in the NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2015-195;

WHEREAS, "MIL-STD 1013" is a military handbook for design guidelines for physical securities and facilities, engineering studies and design (final plans, specifications and cost estimates);

WHEREAS, "MIL-STD 1913" is the established standard methods for uniform and dimensioning of accessory mounting rails and other requirements for weapons that are interchangeable among the weapons of the different units of the Defense Department in the United States of America;

WHEREAS, the need to correct the erroneous entry of "MIL-STD 1013" which may result to confusion in the procurement process, hence, **the** phrase "MIL-STD 1913" be instead applied in the prescribed minimum standard specifications for Reflex (optic) Sight for Rifle under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2015-195 approved last June 16, 2015;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its constitutional powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the correction to the item description required for the Mounting System parameter of "MIL-STD 1013" in NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2015-195 that prescribed the Minimum Standard in the Specifications for Reflex (Optic) Sight for Rifles to read as "MIL-STD 1913".


