RESOLUTION NO. 2016-278

APPROVING THE REVISED FUNCTIONS OF THE PHILIPPINE BOMB DATA CENTER

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Section 14 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, provides that the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) shall exercise administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM issued Resolution No. 2009-547, entitled "Approving the Restructuring of the Philippine National Police (PNP) Intelligence Group (IG), which provides among others the creation of the Philippine Bomb Data Center (PBDC);

WHEREAS, under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2010-087, the administrative and operational control of PBDC was transferred from IG to the Directorate for Intelligence (DI);



WHEREAS, in view of the activation of PNP Explosive Ordnance Disposal and Canine Group (EOD/K9 Group), the functions of the PBDC shall be revised in order to have a clear delineation of functions between the two units;

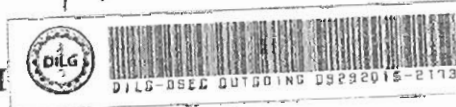
NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional and statutory mandates, **HEREBY RESOLVES TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES**, the following revised functions of the PBDC, to wit:


1. Provides technical intelligence support to PNP EOD/K9 Group, other PNP units, AFP and other law enforcement agencies;
2. Collates, analyses, exploits data intelligence and pieces of evidence pertaining to bomb incidents, bombs, bombers/suspects, organization, leadership and modus operandi;
3. Interprets data gathered by the PBDC Satellite Offices pertaining to explosives and incendiaries, whether commercial, military or improvised;
4. Establishes and maintains rouge's gallery/target list of suspected terrorist, both local and foreign;
5. Maintains case-tracking of bomb related cases;
6. Enlists the assistance of the AFP, National Bureau of Investigation, Philippine Center for Transnational Crimes and any other department, bureau, office, agency, and instrumentality of government-owned or controlled corporations and request the use of their facilities and other resources to carry out its functions;
7. Collaborates with the AFP and other law enforcement agencies in the formulation of policies and fosters mutual cooperation with foreign counterparts;

8. Supports the PNP EOD/K9 Group in the formulation of plans, procedures, protocols and policies pertaining to EOD and CBRN operations;
9. Gathers and maintains data of all bomb related incidents for publication and intelligence research; and
10. Assists the PNP EOD/K9 Group and the PNP Training Service in the conduct of training, seminars and other skills and competency building activities.
