RESOLUTION NO. 2017-170

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2016-098 DATED
AUGUST 4, 2016 THAT PRESCRIBES THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS
FOR THERMAL PRINTER**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2016-098 dated August 4, 2016, has favorably submitted and indorsed the proposed standard specifications for Thermal Printer for consideration and approval by the Commission;

WHEREAS, the subject UESB proposed specification refers to the description and parameter requirements of an office machine which incorporates the functionality of multiple devices in one, so as to have smaller footprint in a home or small business setting and to provide centralized document management/distribution/production in a large-office setting;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB subject proposed specifications will be used in the PNP One-Stop Shop which is a facility that provides all the requirements for the application and renewal of permits, licenses, clearances and other frontline services. It can also be used by the PNP Finance Service, Pensioners and Retirees Benefits Service (PBRs) and other customer-related offices. It is also included in the PNP’s ten (10) year logistics requirements under the PNP Modernization Program;

WHEREAS, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Chairman has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications for Thermal Printer is not tailored-fit specifications to any particular commercial brand of product in the market;

WHEREAS, after thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the Thermal Printer specifications is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by RA No. 8551 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES** the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2016-098, dated August 4, 2016, that

prescribes the minimum standard specifications for Thermal Printer, with slight modification, to read as follows:

I. DESCRIPTION:


Thermal Printer is a type of printer which does not use ink or toner unlike many other printing forms but largely depends on thermal papers for producing images.


I. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

Item Description	Parameters
1) Type	: Direct Thermal or Thermal Transfer
2) Resolution	: 300 dots per inch (dpi)
3) Printing Speed	: 200 millimeter per second (mm/s)
4) Memory	: 16 Megabytes (MB)
5) Printable Width	: 4 inches
6) Cutter	: Built-in
7) Interface	: USB, Wired and Wireless I/O ports
8) System Requirements	: Compatible with Windows 7 or equivalent Operating System

II. MUST PASS THE PNP TEST AND EVALUATION.


