RESOLUTION NO. 2017-279

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2016-106 DATED SEPTEMBER 6, 2016
THAT PRESCRIBES THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
HIGH SPEED TACTICAL WATERCRAFT**

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of Republic Act. No. 8551, empowers the Commission to approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2016-106 dated September 6, 2016, the proposed Minimum Standard Specifications for High Speed Tactical Watercraft;

WHEREAS, PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the descriptions and parameter requirements of an equipment that is a heavily armed tactical water vessel capable of speeds in excess of 70kph. It is highly maneuverable, ideal for shallow waters, and has an average fuel consumption of 1.7L per nautical miles per engine or 5.1L using its three engines. According to the PNP, the watercraft will be used in Maritime Interdiction and Seaborne Operations of Special Action Force (SAF), Maritime Group (MG) and other PNP Special Unit;

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted Certifications from the two (2) manufacturers (Ocean Protecta, Inc. and The Boat Shop Corporation) that they can comply with the specification requirements including the accessories;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed Minimum Standard Specifications for High Speed Tactical Watercraft is not a tailored-fit specification to any manufacturer brand /product in the market;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the Proposed Minimum Standard Specifications for High Speed Tactical Watercraft is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES**, the Minimum Standard Specifications for High Speed Tactical Watercraft, to read as follows:

I. SPECIFICATIONS:

A. Hull

- a.1 Length : 12.19 meters (40 feet)
- a.2 Breadth : 2.9 meters (9 feet 6 inches)
- a.3 Material : Fiberglass
- a.4 Hull Type : Stepped Hull
- a.5 Color : Gray
- a.6 Seating Capacity : 12 persons

B. Outboard Motor

- b.1 Engine Type : 4-stroke
- b.2 Speed : 40 knots
- b.3 Horsepower : 250 hp
- b.4 Fuel Type : Gasoline
- b.5 No. of OBM : 3

C. Fuel Tank Capacity : 2,100 liters

D. Accessories:




