RESOLUTION NO. 2017-293

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS
IN THE SPECIFICATIONS FOR SEARCH AND RESCUE (SAR) HELMET**

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), in Resolution No. 2016-062, dated March 10, 2016, recommended to the Commission the approval of the proposed standard specifications for Search and Rescue (SAR) Helmet;

WHEREAS, the proposed specifications for Search and Rescue (SAR) Helmet refers to a head protection gear used by PNP personnel during the conduct of search and rescue operation that is certified by the PNP to be not a tailored-fit specification to any particular manufacturer’s brand/model available in the market;

WHEREAS, the Commission, finds the same in order and conforms with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission in order to meet the requirements of the PNP;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards in the Specifications for Search and Rescue (SAR) Helmet, with slight modifications, to read as follows:


- I. Technical Specifications

 - d) Certification : With Internationally Accepted Certificate Compliant to Flame Resistance, Marine Safety Helmet, Industrial Eye Protection, Hearing Protection, Impact Protection,




