RESOLUTION No. 2017-321

**GRANTING THE CHIEF, PNP THE AUTHORITY TO RECRUIT FOURTEEN THOUSAND  
 FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-FOUR (14,484) POLICE OFFICERS 1 (PO1s) UNDER  
 THE PNP CY 2017 REGULAR AND ATTRITION RECRUITMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, provides that the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) shall exercise administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission its proposed CY 2017 Regular and Attrition Recruitment Program, which includes separate recruitment quota of ten thousand (10,000) Police Officer 1 (PO1) for regular recruitment and four thousand four hundred and eighty-four (4,484) PO1 for attrition recruitment;

WHEREAS, the attrition recruitment quota of four thousand four hundred and eighty-four (4,484) shall be distributed to the units/offices where PNP personnel were attrited, in order to replenish its personnel complement;

WHEREAS, the regular recruitment quota shall be distributed to all Police Regional Offices (PROs), with the exception of the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO), and to selected National Support Units (NSUs) to strengthen the respective Public Safety Forces (PSFs) and support its personnel build-up program;

WHEREAS, the recruitment quota under the PNP CY 2017 Regular and Attrition Recruitment Program shall be distributed as follows:

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the said Recruitment Program, the Commission finds the same to be in order considering that the recruitment of new Police Officers 1 will replenish personnel losses, increase personnel complement, enhance police visibility and improve the police-to-population ratio and, consequently, the prevailing peace and order condition in the operational area covered by the respective PROs and NSUs;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the Philippine National Police, HAS RESOLVED TO GRANT, AS IT HEREBY GRANTS, the Chief, PNP the authority to recruit fourteen thousand four hundred and eighty-four (14,484) Police Officers 1 (PO1) under the PNP CY 2017 Regular and Attrition Recruitment Program.


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that any amendment to the approved recruitment quota for CY 2017 Regular and Attrition Recruitment Program shall be submitted to the Commission for approval;

RESOLVED, FURTHERMORE, that the distribution of the Attrition Recruitment quota, hereto attached as Annex "A", shall form part of this Resolution;

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the Chiefs of Offices/Units and Members of the various Screening Committees, including the Head and Members of the Secretariat, who shall fail to strictly observe and comply with the rules and regulations on recruitment, selection and appointment of police personnel shall be dealt with under existing rules and regulations.
