RESOLUTION NO. 2017-348

“PRESCRIBING THE RANK OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE ANTI-CYBER CRIME GROUP (ACG) TO BE AT LEAST POLICE CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT”

WHEREAS, Section 14 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, provides that the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) shall exercise administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, the Commission issued NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2013-220, which provides for the activation of the PNP Anti-Cybercrime Group to be headed by a Director with the rank of Police Senior Superintendent;

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission the proposed upgrading of rank of the Director of PNP Anti-Cybercrime Group (ACG), from Police Senior Superintendent to Police Chief Superintendent;

WHEREAS, based on the evaluation of said proposal, the Commission finds the same to be in order considering that such upgrading is consistent with the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10175, which prescribes that the PNP shall create an anti-cybercrime unit to be headed by at least a Police Director;


WHEREAS, the Commission recognizes that the rank Police Chief Superintendent is commensurate to the duties and responsibilities appertaining to the position Director, ACG, which includes the management and continued development of the technical resource capabilities of the PNP for its anti-cybercrime law enforcement mandate;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its constitutional mandate to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, that the rank of the Director, Anti-Cyber Crime Group (ACG) to be at least Police Chief Superintendent.

All other NAPOLCOM issuances or portions thereof which are contrary to, or inconsistent herewith, are hereby modified or repealed accordingly.
