RESOLUTION NO. 2017-368

**APPROVING THE AMENDMENT TO NAPOLCOM RESOLUTION NO. 2016-581,
ON THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATION FOR INTERNET PROTOCOL
PRIVATE BRANCH EXCHANGE (IP-PBX) SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2015-035, dated September 18, 2015, has favorably submitted and indorsed the proposed amendments to the standard specifications for Internet Protocol - Private Branch Exchange (IP-PBX) System for consideration and approval by the Commission;

WHEREAS, the proposed amendment to the standard specifications of Internet Protocol-Private Branch Exchange (IP-PBX) System, particularly in the IP-PBX Server’s Operating System, will allow wider conformity of different product brands of manufacturers which is more advantageous and beneficial to the government and, likewise, will encourage more participants in the procurement process thereof;

WHEREAS, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Chairman has certified that the proposed amendment to the standard specification for Internet Protocol-Private Branch Exchange (IP-PBX) System is not a tailored-fit specification to any particular commercial brand of product in the market;

WHEREAS, after thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the amendment to the Internet Protocol - Private Branch Exchange (IP-PBX) System specification is in order and conforms with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by RA No. 8551 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the amendment to NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2016-581 on the minimum standard specification for Internet Protocol - Private Branch Exchange (IP-PBX) System, to read as follows:


