RESOLUTION NO. 2017-369

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2017-010 DATED MARCH 14, 2017  
THAT PRESCRIBES THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR  
BODY WORN AND DASH CAMERAS**

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of Republic Act. No. 8551, empowers the Commission to approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2017-010 dated March 14, 2017, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for Body Worn and Dash Cameras;

WHEREAS, PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the description and parameter requirement of an equipment that can be worn in the body or installed in the dashboard of a police patrol vehicle of the frontline law enforcers to increase its transparency during legitimate police operation and other activities by recording the event which can be reviewed, studied and used as evidence;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the minimum standard specifications for Body Worn and Dash Cameras is not a tailored fit specifications to any manufacturer brand /product in the market;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the Proposed Minimum Standard Specifications for Body Worn and Dash Cameras are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the Minimum Standard Specifications for Body Worn and Dash Cameras with slight modification to read as follows:

I. SPECIFICATIONS:

A. Camera

- a. Display : 2 inches, colored
- b. Photo : 16 Megapixel
- c. Field of View : 110°
- d. Frame Rate : 30 Frames Per Second
- e. Video Format : WAV, MP4, MOV or AVI
- f. Night Vision : Capable up to 10 meters
- g. Audio : Built-in

B. Other Features

- 1. GPS : Built-in
- 2. Wireless Transmission for Real Time Monitoring : Built-in, Wi-Fi, 3G and 4G Capable
- 3. Storage : 32 Gigabytes, Scalable to 128 Gigabytes
- 4. Battery Life : 8 Hours Continuous Operation
- 5. Ingress Protection : IP 67
- 6. Shock/Impact Resistance : 2 meters
- 7. Date and Time Stamping
- 8. One Touch Easy Activation
- 9. Pre and Post Recorder
- 10. Password Protected/Security Features/Encryption
- 11. Capable to be Integrated to the Command Center

C. Accessories

- 1. Extra Rechargeable Battery or Appropriate Power Bank
- 2. Appropriate Dock and Cables for Charging and Data Transmission
- 3. Appropriate Stable Mounting Clip for Body Worn


