RESOLUTION NO. 2017-383

AUTHORIZING THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE TO ADOPT A 50% PASSING SCORE FOR THE WRITTEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION FOR TECHNICAL OFFICERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PNP LATERAL ENTRY PROGRAM FOR CY 2017

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-312 granted the Chief, PNP the Authority to Fill-up 545 vacancies for the ranks Police Senior Inspector and Police Inspector under the PNP CY 2017 Lateral Entry Program for Technical Officers;

WHEREAS, as compared to previous years, it is only in this year's Lateral Entry Program that massive recruitment of Technical Officers was opened purposely to address the variance in the number of Police Senior Inspectors and Police Inspectors, with the end view of strengthening the corps of Technical Service Officers;

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2017, the Secretariat of the Lateral Entry Board administered the Competitive Examination, pursuant to the requirement of the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular (NMC) No. 2008-006, specifically Section 6 (C) and (F) thereof;

WHEREAS, the examination was participated in by the applicants who are all license holders/CSC eligible, and who passed the initial screening and evaluation made by the respective National Support Units (NSUs);

WHEREAS, based on the formula provided for under Section 6 (C) of NMC 2008-006, an examinee is required to get at least Seventy Percent (70%) of the total number of items given in the examination which is equivalent to 10.5, the minimum passing score as provided for under Section 6 (J) of the above-mentioned circular;

WHEREAS, the outcome of the examination would show that only 53% of the vacancies will be filled-up because of the low turnout of the result; this is on the assumption that all this WCE passers will pass the subsequent recruitment stages.


WHEREAS, the CPNP in his letter, requested the Commission to authorize the PNP to adjust and adopt a new passing score for the applicants in the Written Competitive Examination from 70% to 50%, in order to accommodate additional applicants to advance to the next stage of recruitment and fill up the vacancies;

WHEREAS, after judicious deliberation, the Commission finds the foregoing intervention to be beneficial to the PNP as it would give the latter a wider scope for selection of applicants to be appointed in the PNP officers Corps as Technical Service Officers;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its mandate under Section 14 (a) of RA 6975, as amended by Section 5 of RA 8551, to develop policies and promulgate a police manual prescribing rules and regulations for efficient organization, administration, and operation, including recruitment, selection, promotion, and the

conduct of qualifying entrance and promotional examinations for uniformed members, **RESOLVED**, as it **HEREBY RESOLVES** to authorize the PNP to adopt a passing score of **Fifty Percent (50%)** specifically for the afore-mentioned recruitment.


