RESOLUTION NO. 2018-019

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2017-038 DATED JULY 25, 2017 THAT
PRESCRIBES THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
250HP OUTBOARD MOTOR (OBM)**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2017-038 dated July 25, 2017, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for 250hp Outboard Motor (OBM);

WHEREAS, PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the description and parameter requirement of a propulsion system for boats, consisting of a self-contained unit that includes engine, gearbox and propeller, designed to be affixed to the outside of the transom. It is the most common motorized method of propelling small watercraft that also provides steering control which can be tilted up to an elevated position to eliminate the chances of hitting any debris especially in shallow water that may damage the motor as well as the propeller;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications are not tailored fit specifications of any particular brand in the market;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the Proposed Minimum Standard Specifications for 250hp Outboard Motor (OBM) are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the minimum standard specifications for 250hp Outboard Motor (OBM) en toto, to read as follows:

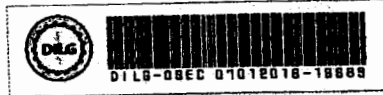
I. SPECIFICATIONS:


- A. Horsepower (fixed requirement) : 250hp
- B. Type : 4-stroke EFI
- C. Number of Cylinder : 4
- D. Displacement : 2000cc
- E. Fuel Type : Gasoline
- F. Starting : Electric
- G. Shaft Length : 25 inches
- H. Propeller : Stainless


II. Must Pass the PNP Test and Evaluation


