RESOLUTION No. - 2018-114

**APPROVING THE RESTRUCTURING AND STRENGTHENING OF THE
NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION POLICE OFFICE (NCRPO)**

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, placed the Philippine National Police (PNP) under the administrative control and operational supervision of the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM);

WHEREAS, Section 25 of R.A. No. 6975 provides for the organization of regional level office of the PNP, including that in the National Capital Region, which shall be headed by a Regional Director;

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission a proposed NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL-17-17, providing for the strengthening and restructuring of the National Capital Region Police Office (NCRPO);

WHEREAS, the proposed reorganization and restructuring of the NCRPO shall include the following:

- a. Creation of a Regional Learning and Doctrine Development Division and Regional Plans and Strategy Management Division;
- b. Renaming of the NCRPO Public Safety Battalion to NCRPO Mobile Force Battalion and the strengthening of its personnel complement;
- c. Renaming of the Regional Police-Community Relations Division to Regional Community Affairs and Development Division; and
- d. Identification of positions for NCRPO uniformed and non-uniformed personnel.

WHEREAS, the additional two (2) divisions are needed to monitor the implementation and application of the PNP doctrines as well as the compliance of the PNP with the requirements of the Performance Governance System, among others;

WHEREAS, the renaming of the NCRPO Public Safety Battalion is in line with the restructuring of PNP Public Safety Forces while the renaming of the Regional Police Community Relations Division is in view of its mandate under the law that the PNP is a "community and service-oriented agency";

WHEREAS, the said strengthening and restructuring of the NCRPO aims to facilitate maximum efficiency and effectiveness in performing its functions, in accordance with the approved organizational structure as provided for under NAPOLCOM Resolution Nos. 93-023 and 96-058, to wit:

- a. Enforce and execute the provisions of the laws, decrees, General Orders, Instructions, Executive Orders, City Charters, and ordinances of local application;
- b. Implement the policies, directives, programs, and projects formulated and adopted by the Chief, PNP in his exercise of the power of administrative and operational control and supervision over the police;

- c. Monitor, coordinate, and evaluate the implementation of PNP policies, directives, programs, and projects at the regional level;
- d. Exercise the powers of appointment and promotion in accordance with the prescribed rules or make necessary recommendations pertinent thereto;
- e. Exercise disciplinary powers in accordance with the existing laws, rules and regulations;
- f. Issue detailed implementing policies and instructions regarding personnel, funds, properties, records, correspondence, and such other matters as may be necessary to effectively carry out the functions, powers, and duties of the Philippine National Police at the regional level; and
- g. Perform other tasks as directed by the Chief, PNP or as may be prescribed by law or PNP directives, rules, and regulations.

WHEREAS, due to the restructuring of the NCRPO Headquarters, it shall maintain nine (9) Regional Staff, namely:

- a. Regional Personnel and Records Management Division (RPRMD or R1);
- b. Regional Intelligence Division (RID or R2);
- c. Regional Operations Division (ROD or R3);
- d. Regional Logistics and Research and Development Division (RLRDD or R4);
- e. Regional Community Affairs and Development Division (RCADD or R5);
- f. Regional Comptrollership Division (RCD or R6);
- g. Regional Investigation and Detective Management Division (RIDMD or R7);
- h. Regional Learning and Doctrine Development Division (RLDDD or R8): and
- i. Regional Plans and Strategy Management Division (RPSMD or R9).

WHEREAS, as a result of the strengthening of the NCRPO, it shall be composed of the following PNP uniformed and non-uniformed personnel:

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Revised Functional Chart and Revised Organizational Structure and Staffing Pattern of the NCRPO, as provided for in the attached NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL 17-17, shall form part of this Resolution.

All other issuances or any part thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
