RESOLUTION NO. 2018-207

APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2017-040 DATED AUGUST 10, 2017
THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
TRACKING OPTICS (FIRE CONTROL SYSTEM)

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the PNP through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2017-040 dated August 10, 2017, recommended to the Commission for approval the proposed minimum standard specifications for Tracking Optics (Fire Control System);

WHEREAS, the Tracking Optics (Fire Control System) refers to an add-on sight system device to be attached on a standard weapon to aid a shooter to precisely hit a given target. It is a highly classified equipment protected with patent to an Israeli manufacturing company named Smart Shooter Ltd. and accordingly no other similar product brands of such equipment are available in the market;

WHEREAS, the Smart Shooter Ltd. has the authority from the Ministry of Defense of Israel to export the Tracking Optics (Fire Control System) to the Philippines;

WHEREAS, after thorough review and evaluation of the UESB resolution on the subject proposed minimum standard specifications, the Commission finds the same in order and conforms with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), all existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, “In Toto”, the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2017-040 dated August 10, 2017 that prescribed the minimum standard specifications for Tracking Optics (Fire Control System), to read as follows:

Particulars	Specifications
a) Weapon Integration	Add-on system to standard weapon
b) Technology	Target Tracking Algorithms
c) Image Processing	With Target Detection and Tracking and capable to suggest a threat (target)
d) Guided Trigger/Trigger Control	With Guided Trigger
e) Day/Night Capability	With Day and Night Mode
f) Maximum Weight	1.5kgs
g) Environmental Engineering	MIL-STAD-810G
h) Miscellaneous	User Handbook in English

RESOLVED FURTHER, that in the event that there are other manufacturing companies producing similar item, this Resolution will be null and void.




