RESOLUTION NO. 2018-246

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2017-048 DATED SEPTEMBER 26, 2017
THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
UNTRAINED DOG (GREEN DOG)**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2017-048 dated September 26, 2017, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for Untrained Dog (Green Dog);

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the description and parameter requirement of an untrained dog that could be trained by the PNP specialized unit as Explosive Detection Dog (EDD), Narcotics Detection Dog (NDD), Protection and Security Patrol Dog (PSPD), Search and Rescue Dog (SARD) and Combat Tracking Dog (CTD) based on the requirement of the PNP;

WHEREAS, untrained dog is much cheaper in terms of pricing, hence more working dogs can be procured by the PNP which can be deployed/utilized to different applications;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications is not tailored fit to any particular brand in the market;

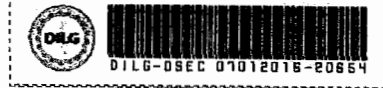
WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standard specifications for Untrained Dog (Green Dog) is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;




