RESOLUTION NO. 2018-274

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2018-002 DATED JANUARY 16, 2018
THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
GUN LIDAR**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;”

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2018-002 dated January 16, 2018, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for Gun Lidar;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the description and parameter requirement of a handheld device that uses lasers to detect the speed of vehicles that are in the path of beam which allows officers to accurately hone in on one specific vehicle to aid PNP personnel in the apprehension of over speeding vehicles to ensure safety and security of all motorist and road users;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications is not tailored fit to any particular brand in the market;


WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standard specifications for Gun Lidar is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES, the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2018-002 dated January 16, 2018 that prescribed the minimum standard specifications for Gun Lidar, with slight modifications, to read as follows:


I. SPECIFICATIONS:


- A. Type : Handheld
- B. Housing/Casing : Based on the Manufacturer's Product Brand Specifications as offered in the Brochures
- C. Distance Accuracy : $\pm 0.15\text{m}$
- D. Measuring Speed Range : Up to 320 km/h
- E. Speed Accuracy : $\pm 2\text{ km/h}$
- F. Laser Technology : Applicable standards for Class 1 Laser Device
- G. Interface : USB and/or Bluetooth
- H. Power Supply : Rechargeable Battery
- I. Power Source : 220V charger




