RESOLUTION NO. 2018-462

APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2018-022 DATED MARCH 27, 2018
THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
ANTI-SNIPING DEVICE

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2018-022 dated March 27, 2018, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for Anti-Sniping Device;

WHEREAS, the PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to the description and parameter requirements of a multi-functional thermal imaging equipment designed for detection of optical and optoelectronic sights by a splash of light from focally arranged elements of the optical system and for finding their range;

WHEREAS, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications is not tailored fit to any particular brand in the market;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standard specifications for Anti-Sniping Device is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IF HEREBY APPROVES, the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2018-022 dated March 27, 2018, that prescribed the minimum standard specifications for Anti-Sniping Device with slight modifications, to read as follows:


I. SPECIFICATIONS

1. Day Time Imaging Capability
 - 1.1. Objective lens : 50mm
 - 1.2. Sensor Type : Based on the Manufacturer's Product Brand Specifications as offered in the Brochures
 - 1.3. Sensor Resolution : 1952 x 1241 pixels
 - 1.4. Field of View : 3.4° (h) x 2.5° (v)
 - 1.5. Display Type and resolution : Based on the Manufacturer's Product Brand Specifications as offered in the Brochures
2. Optical Device Detection Capability
 - 2.1. Detection Range : 70m to 2,000m
 - 2.2. Maximum scanning speed : 30°/ second
 - 2.3. Measuring Accuracy : ± 10m
3. Thermal Imaging Capability
 - 3.1. Objective Lens : 40mm
 - 3.2. Sensor Type : Based on the Manufacturer's Product Brand Specifications as offered in the Brochures
 - 3.3. Sensor Resolution : 640 x 480 pixels
 - 3.4. Spectral Range : Based on the Manufacturer's Product Brand Specifications as offered in the Brochures
 - 3.5. Field of View : 14° (h) x 11° (v)

6. Operation Temperature : -20°C to +45° C


