RESOLUTION NO. 2018-691

**PROVIDING A FIXED LEVEL OF PASSING FOR THE POLICE EXECUTIVE
SERVICE ELIGIBILITY (PESE) WRITTEN EXAMINATION AND
VALIDATION INTERVIEW**

WHEREAS, Section 32 of Republic Act 6975, otherwise known as the PNP Law of 1990, as amended by Section 21 of R.A. No. 8551, provides that the National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examinations for policemen on the basis of the standards set by the Commission;

WHEREAS, Section 38 (a) of R.A No. 6975, as amended by Section 33 of R.A. No. 8551, also provides that *"A uniformed member of the PNP shall not be eligible for promotion to a higher position or rank unless he or she has successfully passed the corresponding promotional examination given by the Commission, or the Bar, or the corresponding board examinations for technical services and other professions, has satisfactorily completed the appropriate and accredited course in the PNPA or equivalent training, and has passed the required psychiatric/psychological and drug test.xxx"*;

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in its rulling clarified that *"it is the promotional examination administered by the National Police Commission which would entitle a police officer to the appropriate eligibility for promotion. (G.R. No. 141732 dated April 17, 2001)*;

WHEREAS, in compliance with the foregoing mandate, the National Police Commission issued Resolution No. 2006-082, "Prescribing the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE) for the ranks of Senior Superintendent and higher in the PNP, Amending for the purpose NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2002-034";

WHEREAS, the Commission conducts two (2) phases of the PESE. Phase I is the Written Examination and Phase II is the Validation Interview;

WHEREAS, after eleven (11) years of administering the PESE there is a need to set a fixed level of passing for the PESE Written Phase and Interview Phase;

WHEREAS, the PESE Executive Committee meeting tackled the level of passing for Written and Interview Examination Phases;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its Constitutional mandate to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES the standard for passing the PESE as follows:

1. Phase I, Written Examination – Only examinees who obtained 50% of the correct answers of the total test items shall proceed to the Validation Interview Phase.
2. Phase II, Validation Interview – Only those who obtained an outstanding rating during the interview shall be conferred a PES Eligibility.
 - 2.a. Examinees in 2018 and thereafter, who will fail in the interview may be allowed to apply for re-interview **twice** for the next two (2) years from the date of the last interview. Examinees who will not pass the Interview Phase during said period shall be required to re-take the Written Examination and Validation Interview.
 - 2.b. Examinees in 2017 or earlier who failed in the interview may apply for re-interview only **once**. Examinees who will not pass shall be required to re-take the Written Examination and Validation Interview.

Examinees in 2017 and earlier who failed in the re-interview or who were not able to attend the scheduled interview as prescribed herein, shall repeat the Written Examination and Validation Interview.
