**RESOLUTION No. 2019-261**

**APPROVING THE RESTRUCTURING AND STRENGTHENING OF THE OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY CHIEF, PNP FOR OPERATIONS (ODCO)**

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, placed the Philippine National Police (PNP) under the administrative control and operational supervision of the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM);

**WHEREAS**, the Commission issued NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-167, entitled: ***“Amending NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2010-311, entitled: Approving the Restructuring of the Office of the Deputy Chief, Philippine National Police (PNP) for Operations”***, in consideration of NHQ-PNP General Order Number DPL 16-16 and based on the premise that it shall improve organizational efficiency of the ODCO by ensuring its adaptability to relevant standards and practices, streamlining workflow processes and effectively and efficiently achieving its mandated functions with the least number of personnel;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP requested the amendment of NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-167 by strengthening the organizational structure of the ODCO in order to effectively and efficiently accomplish its task;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP contends that the restructuring of the ODCO under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-167 is not responsive to the organizational requirements of the Office and that the proposal to amend the said NAPOLCOM Resolution will not in any manner disturb the existing structure of ODCO since the PNP has yet to implement its restructuring as provided under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-167:

**WHEREAS**, the PNP in order to sustain the development of more responsive organizational structures of the PNP Command Group, submitted for consideration of the Commission a proposed NHQ-PNP General Orders No. DPL-17-11 which provides for the manpower reinforcement of the ODCO that would amend NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2017-167;

**WHEREAS**, the Office of the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Assist the Chief, PNP in the exercise of responsibilities relative to PNP operations, plans, intelligence, community relations, and investigation activities;
- b. Assist the Chief, PNP in directing, controlling, and supervising the national operational support units; and
- c. As third in command, the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations shall exercise duties that may be delegated to him by the Chief, PNP.

**WHEREAS**, The ODCO shall be composed of the following Units:

Unit	Rank of the Chief
1. Administrative and Security Unit (ADSU)	Police Superintendent
2. Special Concerns Management Unit (SCMU)	Police Senior Superintendent

**WHEREAS**, the SCMU shall assist the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations on matters pertaining to the administration and management of the following major areas of concerns:

- a. The QUAD/Plans Concerns which shall cover the Directorate for Operations, Directorate for Intelligence, Directorate for Investigation and Detective Management, Directorate for Police Community Relations, all National Operational Support Units (NOSUs) and other tasked PNP Offices/Units; and
- b. The Integrated Police Operations Concern which shall include all Directorates for Integrated Police Operations (DIPOs).

**WHEREAS**, the ODCO shall be complemented by the following officers and personnel:



GENERAL ORDERS  
NUMBER DPL-17- 11**

**RESTRUCTURING AND STRENGTHENING  
OF THE OFFICE OF THE DEPUTY CHIEF, PNP FOR OPERATIONS**

1. Effective this date, the Office of the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations, with official acronym "ODCO", shall be restructured and strengthened as reflected in Annex B hereof to effectively carry out its mandate as provided for under Section 35(b) of Republic Act No. 6975 and NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 93-023.

2. Consistent with the provisions NHQ-PNP Circular No. DPL-03-02, dated October 26, 2003, entitled "Specific Authority Delegated to the Directorial Staff", the Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations (TDCO), through the Chief of Directorial Staff (TCDS), shall have supervisory authority over the following members of the Directorial Staff: The Director for Intelligence (TDI); The Director for Operations (TDO); The Director for Plans (TDPL); The Director for Police-Community Relations (TDPCR); The Director for Investigation and Detective Management (TDIDM); and all Directors for Integrated Police Operations.

3. The Deputy Chief, PNP for Operations shall have the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Assist the Chief, PNP in the exercise of responsibilities relative to PNP operations, plans, intelligence, community relations, and investigation activities;
- b. Assist the Chief, PNP in directing, controlling, and supervising the national operational support units; and
- c. As third in command, he shall exercise duties that may be delegated to him or as directed by the Chief, PNP.

4. The ODCO shall be composed of the Administrative and Security Unit (ADSU) and Special Concerns Management Unit (SCMU).

5. The SCMU shall assist TDCO on matters pertaining to the administration and management of the two major areas of concern as follows: (a) the QUAD/Plans Concerns which shall cover the DO, DI, DIDM, DPCR, all National Operational Support Units (NOSU)s and other tasked PNP Offices/Units; and (b) the Integrated Police Operations Concern which shall include all Directorates for Integrated Police Operations (DIPOs).

6. The ODCO shall have a complement of 40 personnel broken down as follows: 12 Police Commissioned Officers with the ranks of PSINSP to PDDGEN, 20 Police Non-Commissioned Officers with the ranks of PO3 to SPO4, and 8 Non-Uniformed Personnel. It shall be supported by one Servicing Legal Officer from Legal Service and Information Technology Officer from the Information and Communication Technology Management Service.

7. Requisite support pertaining to personnel, logistics, funds, and other resources for the smooth implementation of this directive shall be provided by the concerned Directorial Staff, subject to the existing policies and procedures and approval of the Chief, PNP.

8. The issuance of this General Orders is in pursuance of the vested power of the Chief, PNP under Section 26 of Republic Act No. 6975. As such, all directives/publications in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.

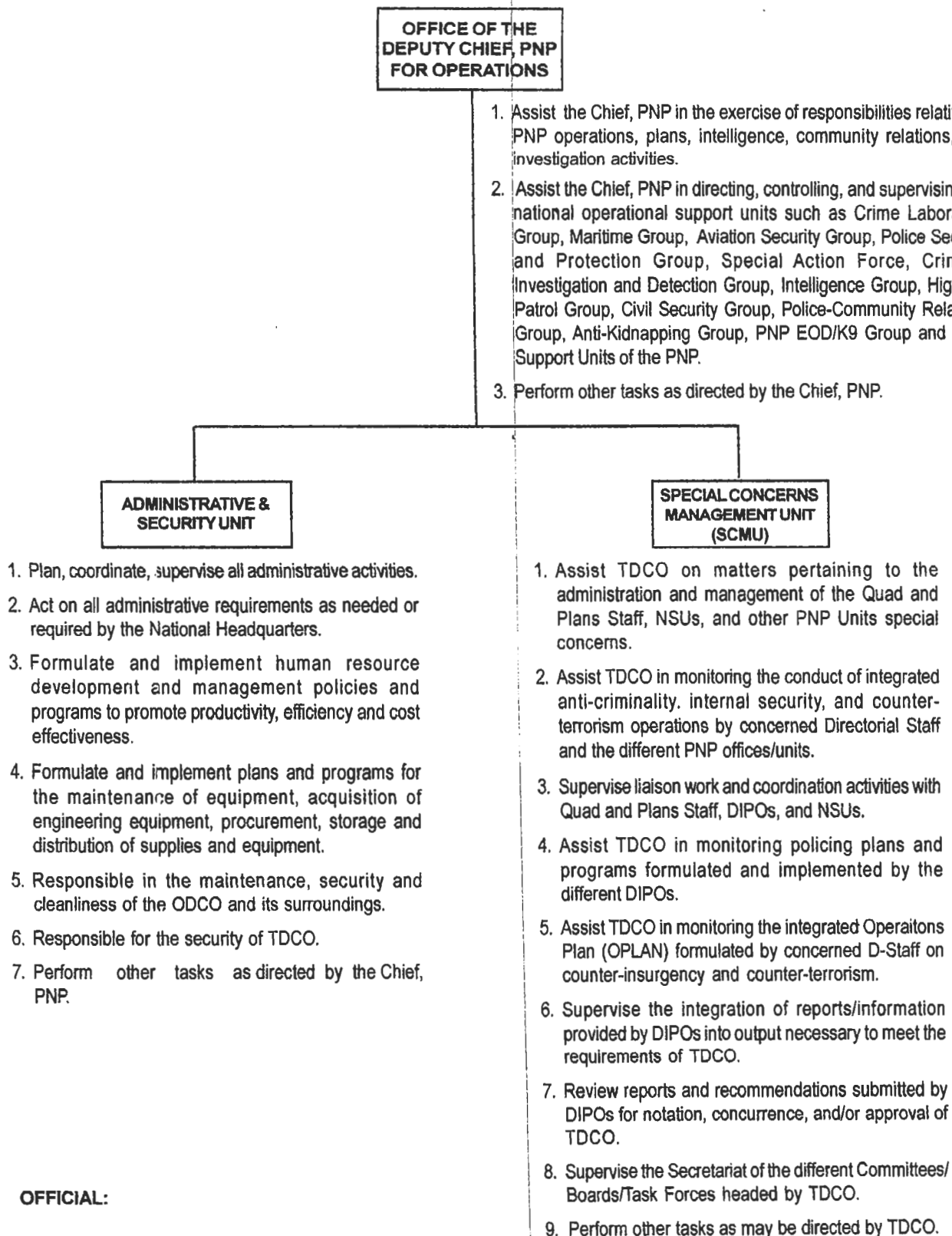

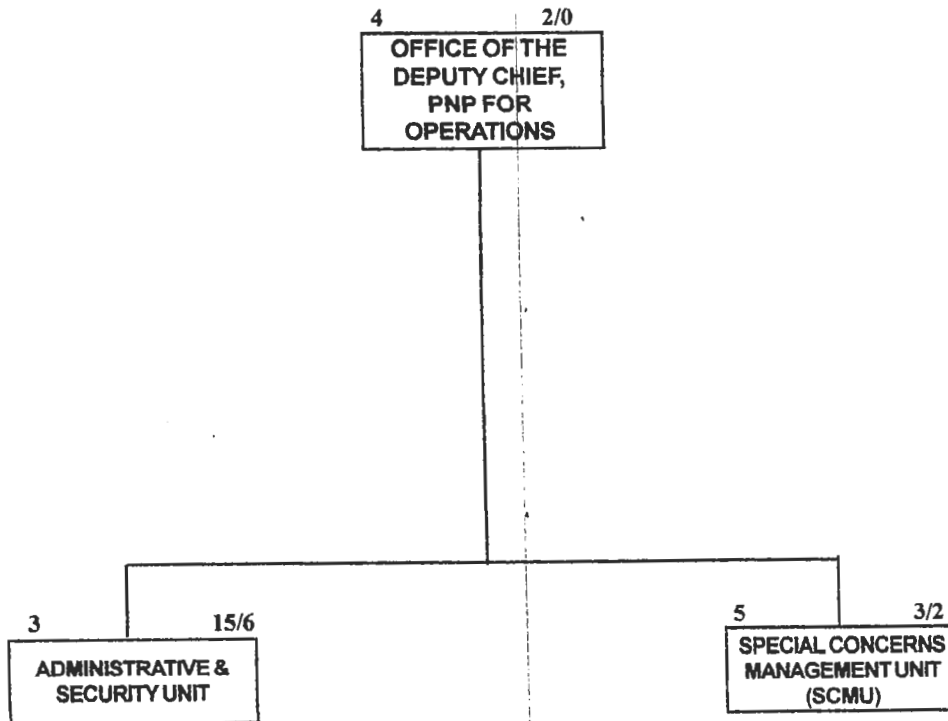
**PROPOSED FUNCTIONAL CHART

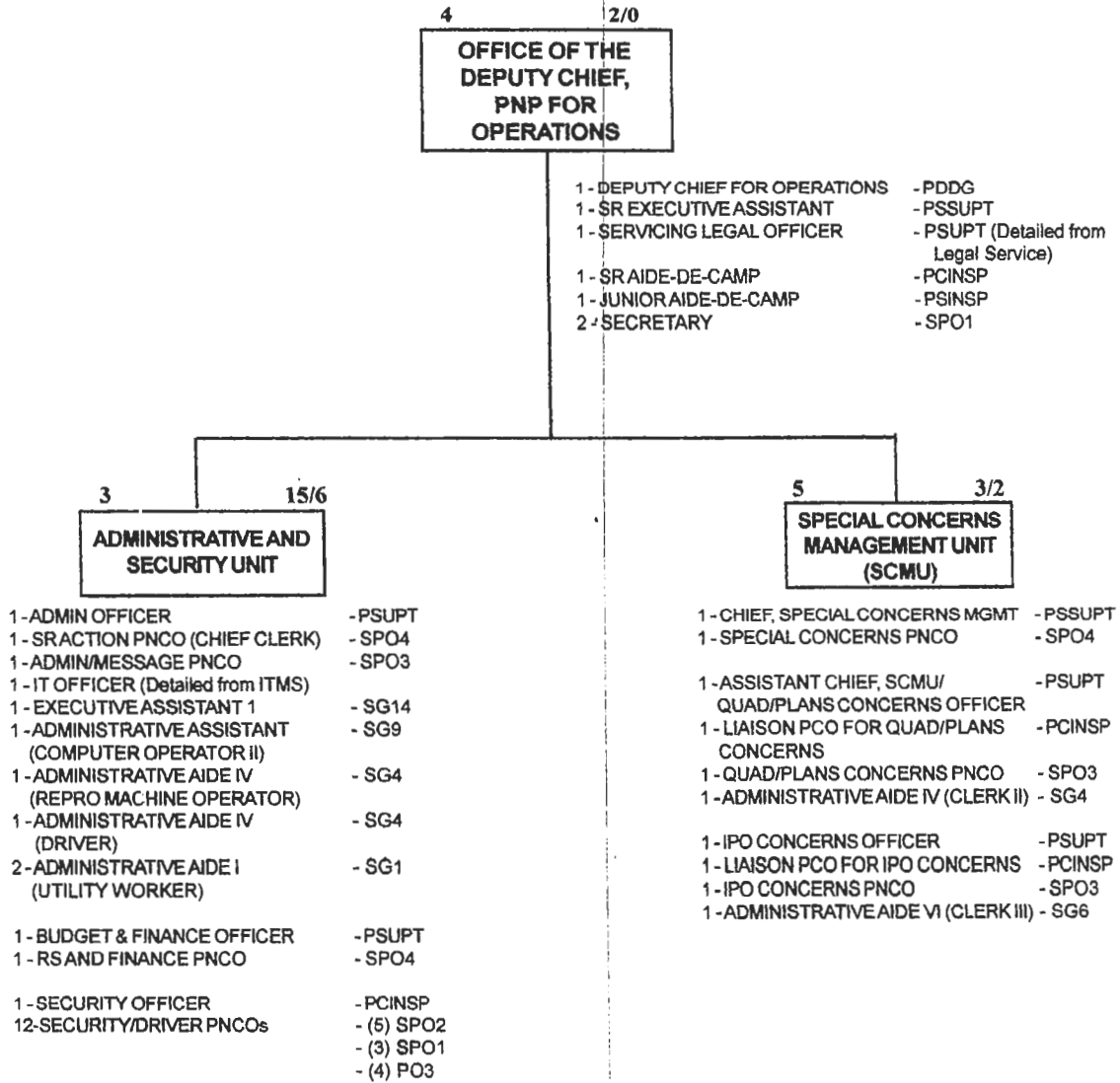
