**RESOLUTION No. - 2019-318**

**APPROVING THE UPGRADING OF THE RANKS OF SEVENTY-EIGHT (78)  
POSITIONS OF THE CHIEFS OF REGIONAL OFFICES/UNITS OF NATIONAL  
SUPPORT UNITS (NSUs) FROM POLICE LIEUTENANT COLONEL  
TO POLICE COLONEL**

**WHEREAS**, the Constitution and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, placed the Philippine National Police (PNP) under the administrative control and operational supervision of the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM);

**WHEREAS**, Section 35 of R.A. No. 6975 provides for the creation of PNP administrative and operational support units;

**WHEREAS**, at present, out of the one hundred twenty-six (126) identified Regional Chief positions for the Regional Offices/Units of the Financial Service, Health Service, Training Service, Chaplain Service, Legal Service, Intelligence Group, Highway Patrol Group, and Police Security and Protection Group, forty-eight (48) are already prescribed with the rank of Police Senior Superintendent while the remaining seventy-eight (78) positions are still Police Superintendent;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission a proposed NHQ-PNP General Order Number DPL-18-28, providing for the upgrading of seventy-eight (78) positions of Chiefs of Regional Offices/Units of National Support Units from Police Lieutenant Colonel to Police Colonel, as follows;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed upgrading of the aforesaid ranks is in pursuance of Joint Resolution No. 4, otherwise known as the **“Salary Standardization Law of 2009”**, which provides that: a) all government personnel shall be paid just and equitable compensation in accordance with the principle of equal pay for work of equal value; and b) that the military personnel of the Department of National Defense and the uniformed personnel of the Department of the Interior and Local Government shall be covered by a compensation system that will promote pay equity for an effective, efficient, professional and motivated corps of military and uniformed personnel;

**WHEREAS**, after review of the PNP’s submission and in consideration of all the above, the Commission finds the same to be in order considering that the upgrading of ranks of the concerned Chiefs of the Regional Offices/Units will boost their morale and shall further enhance their capability and efficiency in performing their mandated functions;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission, in the exercise of its administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police, **HAS RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES TO APPROVE**, the upgrading of the ranks of seventy-eight (78) positions of the Chiefs of Regional Offices/Units of National Support Units (NSUs) from Police Lieutenant Colonel to Police Colonel.


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the attached NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL-18-28 shall form part of this Resolution.


All other issuances or any part thereof which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
