RESOLUTION No. 2019-383

**APPROVING THE RESTRUCTURING AND STRENGTHENING OF THE
DIRECTORATE FOR PLANS (DPL)**

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, placed the Philippine National Police (PNP) under the administrative control and operational supervision of the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM);

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM issued Resolution No. 92-036, entitled: ***“Approving the Revised Organizational Structure of the Philippine National Police (PNP) and Providing Policies and Guidelines in the Implementation Thereof”***, providing, among others, for the creation of the Directorate for Plans which is composed of three (3) Divisions, namely: Plans and Programs Division, Organizational Development Division, and Special Projects Development Division;

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission a copy of the proposed NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL 18-11, entitled: ***“Restructuring and Strengthening of Unit (Directorate for Plans)”***;

WHEREAS, the restructuring and strengthening of the Directorate for Plans (DPL) aims to modify its functions, its Divisions and the creation of Centers in accordance with NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 93-023, dated May 27, 1993, and its additional mandates as provided for under Executive Order No. 97, series of 2002, entitled: ***“Executive Order Approving and Adopting the Policy Framework and Guidelines for Philippine Participation in United Nations (UN) Peacekeeping Operations”***;

WHEREAS, the DPL shall perform the following functions, to wit:

- a. Formulate and supervise the execution of PNP plans and programs that are beyond immediate operational and tactical range;
- b. Develop and monitor the implementation of policies and directives on organizational and force development of the PNP;
- c. Undertake program development, monitoring and evaluation of existing strategic plans and programs, and recommend necessary amendment thereof;
- d. Initiate appropriate action on PNP legislative initiatives and agenda, and priority bills for PNP reforms and development, in coordination with the Congress of the Philippines and other concerned government agencies and PNP Offices/Units;
- e. Collaborate and participate in joint planning activities with the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) and other planning offices of the government for the crafting of strategic plans on peace, security, and development concerns; and
- f. In coordination with the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA), collaborate with the United Nations, foreign embassies, police agencies abroad, and international organizations on matters concerning international commitments, and foreign bilateral and multilateral talks and agreements.
- g. Perform other tasks as directed by the Chief, PNP.

WHEREAS, the Command Group of the DPL shall be composed of the following:

Position	Rank
1. Director	Police Major General
2. Deputy Director	Police Brigadier General
3. Executive Officer	Police Brigadier General

WHEREAS, the DPL shall be composed of the following Divisions and Centers:

Division/Center	Rank of the Chief
1. Plans and Programs Division (PPD)	Police Colonel
2. Organizational Development Division (ODD)	Police Colonel
3. Inter-Agency and International Affairs Division (IA & IAD)	Police Colonel
4. United Nations Peacekeeping Operations Center (UNPOC)	Police Colonel
5. Legislative Affairs Center (LAC)	Police Colonel

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES**, the restructuring and strengthening of the Directorate for Plans.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that there are positions held by Uniformed Personnel which will eventually be replaced by Non-Uniformed Personnel upon approval of the Department of Budget and Management;


