RESOLUTION NO. 2019-482

**APPROVING THE UPGRADING OF MALAY MUNICIPAL POLICE STATION (MPS)
FROM TYPE "B" MPS TO A SPECIAL TYPE "A" MPS**

WHEREAS, the Constitution and Republic Act (R.A.) No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, placed the Philippine National Police (PNP) under the administrative control and operational supervision of the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM);

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 2005-140, entitled: *"Resolution Amending Sections "E", "G" and "H" of NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 92-036 entitled Approving the Revised Organizational Structure of the Philippine National Police and Providing Policies and Guidelines in the Implementation Thereof"*, which provides new parameters for the categorization/classification of Police Provincial Offices, City Police Offices, and Component City/Municipal Police Stations;

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission a copy of proposed NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL-18-21, providing for the strengthening of Malay Municipal Police Station (MPS) and categorizing it as a Special Type "A" MPS, exempting it from the provisions of NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2005-140;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Malay has a 1st class income classification per Department of Finance Order No. 23-08 dated July 29, 2008, and a population of 52,973 based from CY 2015 Philippine Statistics Authority data;

WHEREAS, under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2005-140, a Type "A" MPS should have a town population of 85,000 and above and a 1st to 3rd Class income Classification;

WHEREAS, Boracay Island as one of the top tourist destinations greatly contributes to the country's economy;

WHEREAS, from data culled from the Tourism Office of the Municipality of Malay, the island of Boracay consists of the Barangays of Manoc-Manoc, Balabag and Yapak, with a total land area of 1,006.64 hectares, and a total population of 32,267;

WHEREAS, in addition to the population thereat, the Department of Tourism estimated the daily tourist presence in Boracay Island at 30,000 and the number of workers per day at 27,487;

WHEREAS, in CY 2017, Boracay Island recorded a total of 2,001,974 visitors and generated a total of Php56,147,744,220.60 in tourism receipts, according to Aklan Provincial Tourism Office;

WHEREAS, in order to sustain the robust tourism in the island, special emphasis should be given on the safety and security of its tourists and inhabitants;

WHEREAS, the PNP is recommending that Malay MPS be exempted from the provisions of NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2005-140 and that it be considered as a Special Type "A" MPS in order to sustain the government's efforts at intensifying security measures surrounding the Boracay Island and proactively deter the spillover of terrorism and violent extremism, repression of prevalent crimes, entry of illegal drugs, smuggling and other crimes of such magnitude;

WHEREAS, the salient features of the proposed strengthening of Malay MPS are as follows:

- a. Upgrading the rank of Chief of Police, Malay MPS, Aklan PPO, PRO 6 from Police Major to Police Lieutenant Colonel, and the rank of Deputy Chief of Police from Police Senior Inspector to Police Chief Inspector;
- b. Increase in the authorized complement of Malay MPS, Aklan PPO from 242 to 418 personnel;
- c. Creation of a 71-man Mobile and Seaborne Patrol Unit under the Operations Section composed of five 8-man beach patrol teams;
- d. Establishment of an 11-man SWAT Team under the Operations Section;
- e. Provision for a nine-man EOD/K9 Team (to be detailed from the PNP-EOD/K9 Group and placed under the operational control of the Chief of Police, Malay MPS, Aklan PPO);
- f. Provision of five standard 55-man Police-Community Precincts (PCPs);
- g. Provision of three Tourist Assistance PNCOs in every PCP;
- h. Creation of two positions for Foreign Liaison PNCOs under the Intelligence Section; and
- i. Provision of operational support from the 605th Maritime Section of the Maritime Group (MG), which shall be placed under the operational control of Malay MPS, Aklan PPO.

WHEREAS, after review of the PNP's submission and in consideration of the abovesited premises, the Commission finds the upgrading of the Malay MPS in order considering that it will enhance the security and protection of both the tourists/travelers and inhabitants in the Municipality of Malay, especially the island of Boracay;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police, **HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY APPROVES**, the upgrading of the Malay Municipal Police Station from a Type "B" MPS to a Special Type "A" Municipal Police Station.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the attached NHQ-PNP General Orders Number DPL-18-21, which provides for the organizational structure and staffing pattern of Malay MPS, Aklan PPO, PRO 6, shall form part of this Resolution.


