**RESOLUTION NO. 2019-487**

**APPROVING THE PNP-UESB RESOLUTION NO. 2018-056 DATED NOVEMBER 27, 2018 THAT PRESCRIBED THE MINIMUM STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR AUTOMATED URINE ANALYZER**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;"

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB), Resolution No. 2018-056 dated November 27, 2018, the prepared Minimum Standard Specifications for Automated Urine Analyzer;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP UESB proposed minimum standard specifications refer to an Automated Urine Analyzer which is a dedicated system for the analysis of chemical and microscopic formed elements in urine specimen;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) has certified that the proposed minimum standard specifications are not tailored-fit to any particular brand in the market;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standard specifications for Automated Urine Analyzer are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the PNP-UESB Resolution No. 2018-056 dated November 27, 2018, that prescribed the minimum standard specifications for Automated Urine Analyzer with slight modification, to read as follows;
