RESOLUTION NO. 2019-548

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR DEEP DIVE LIGHTS

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2019-011 dated April 11, 2019, recommended to the Commission for approval the proposed minimum standards for Deep Dive Lights;

WHEREAS, records showed that there is an existing standard specifications for PNP Scuba Dive Lights under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2003-087 dated September 16, 2003, as amended by NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2009-147 dated March 12, 2009, which is basically the same as the Deep Dive Lights but presented in a more detailed manner including its technical specifications;

WHEREAS, the PNP-UESB subject proposed minimum standards for Deep Dive Lights refer to a handheld self-contained lights to be carried during underwater (fresh and sea) mission such as but not limited to training, search and rescue/recovery operation, underwater investigation, and security operation;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the same in order and conforms with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), and all existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBED, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Deep Dive Lights, to read as follows:


Particular	Standards
a. Equipment Type	Deep Dive Lights
b. Description	A handheld self-contained light source with a wide beam angle. Typically bright and are designed to be used during daytime and night time dives in murky or deep sea and fresh waters
c. Purpose	An equipment to be carried by the PNP divers to provide maximum visibility in an underwater environment
d. Equipment capability	Capable for at least 100m deep dive

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications of the Deep Dive Lights which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the same complies, conforms and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, RA 9184 otherwise known as the procurement law and are advantageous to the PNP.

FURTHERMORE, that all other existing specifications which are inconsistent with these minimum standards for Deep Dive Lights are hereby **CANCELLED/ REPEALED/REVOKED** accordingly
