RESOLUTION NO. 2019-739

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR ID CARD PRINTER

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;”

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019 defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Chairman and Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through its endorsement letter dated June 14, 2019, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission the proposed Minimum Standards for ID Card Printer;

WHEREAS, the ID Card Printer is intended to be utilized to print PNP ID cards such as License To Own and Possess Firearms (LTOPF), License to Exercise Security Profession (LESP), Firearms Registration (FR) and other PNP Unit cards;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for ID Card Printer is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the minimum standards for ID Card Printer, to read as follows:

Particulars	Minimum Standards
Description	A special type of electronic printer designed to print different types of identity plastic cards. It is durable, with customized security features and maximized operational efficiency.
Performance and Function	High capacity, can print voluminous cards
System	Compatible with any platforms
Security	Equipped with maximum security features to protect from counterfeit copying


Particulars	Minimum Standards
Printing Capability	Edge to edge, single or double sided printing
Printing Method	Dye Sublimation, Reverse Transfer or equivalent method
Printing Speed	Handfed or Single Feed, Batch Printing or equivalent method


RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications of the ID Card Printer, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the said specification complies, conforms and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184 otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and are advantageous to the PNP.
