RESOLUTION NO. 2019-755

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR VERY HIGH FREQUENCY (VHF)
LOW BAND TACTICAL HANDHELD RADIO TRANSCEIVER**

WHEREAS, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;"

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019 defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP Directorate for Research and Development endorsed for approval the proposed Minimum Standards for Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver as provided under PNP Technical Working Group for the Formulation and Amendment of Standard (TWG-FAS) Resolution No. 2019-001;

WHEREAS, the Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver is a ruggedized, lightweight, reliable and secured communication equipment that can withstand rough handling and changing environmental condition, to be used by PNP operating units during tactical and critical operation;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standard for Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the minimum standards for Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver, to read as follows:

Particulars	Minimum Standards
Type	Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver
Description	A ruggedized and fully synthesized portable tactical transceiver with frequency hopping enclosed in a case of high impact materials to withstands shock, vibration, humidity and immersion on fresh and salt water.
Equipment Capability	Capable of short-range two-way wireless voice and data communication, with security/encryption feature, provides location information and extends signals coverage.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications of the Very High Frequency (VHF) Low Band Tactical Handheld Radio Transceiver, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the said specification complies, conforms and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provision of Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and are advantageous to the PNP.

FURTHERMORE, all issuances inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby amended/repealed/rescinded.




