RESOLUTION No. 2020- 0060

**GRANTING THE OFFICER-IN-CHARGE, OFFICE OF THE CHIEF, PNP THE
AUTHORITY TO RECRUIT FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-ONE (4,631)
PATROLMAN/PATROLWOMAN UNDER THE PNP
CY 2019 ATTRITION RECRUITMENT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 6975, as amended, provides that the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) shall exercise administrative control and operational supervision over the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, the PNP submitted for consideration of the Commission the CY 2019 Attrition Recruitment Program which provides for the recruitment of four thousand six-hundred thirty-one (4,631) Patrolman/Patrolwoman;

WHEREAS, the attrition recruitment quota of 4,631 Patrolman/Patrolwoman shall be distributed to the Mobile Force of the Police Regional Offices in order to address the insurgency problems in their area of responsibility and to the National Support Units (NSUs), specifically the Maritime Group (MG), Aviation Security Group (AVSEGROUP), and the Special Action Force (SAF) to meet their operational requirements;

WHEREAS, the attrition recruitment quota shall be distributed as follows:

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the said program, the Commission communicated to the PNP that the proposed quota distribution was not aligned with the number of police officers actually attrited in the various Police Regional Offices and National Support Units in CY 2018, hence recommended that the attrition recruitment quota be allocated to the particular PNP Offices/Units where there were personnel attrition to ensure the replacement of all uniformed personnel attrited;

WHEREAS, the PNP, in response, requested the Commission to reconsider its position and allow the PNP to process the submitted attrition recruitment quota distribution which has already been disseminated. considering that the applicants were already undergoing the recruitment process, and that the allocated budget was already released to the different recruiting offices/units;


WHEREAS, the PNP likewise requested that it be allowed to adjust the distribution of quota to PROs/NSUs with shortage of personnel due to said attrition during the regular recruitment program for CY 2020;

WHEREAS, in view thereof and in order not to protract the on-going PNP attrition recruitment program for CY 2019, the Commission hereby grants the Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Chief, PNP the authority to recruit 4,631 Patrolman/Patrolwoman with the condition that necessary adjustments shall be done by the PNP during the regular recruitment program for CY 2020 to rectify shortage of personnel at the PROs/NSUs due to attrition in CY 2018;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the Philippine National Police, **HAS RESOLVED TO GRANT, AS IT HEREBY GRANTS**, the Officer-in-Charge, Office of the Chief, PNP the authority to recruit four thousand six hundred thirty-one (4,631) Patrolman/Patrolwoman under the PNP CY 2019 Attrition Recruitment Program.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Chiefs of Offices/Units and members of the Screening Committee, including the head and members of the Secretariat, who shall fail to strictly observe and comply with the rules and regulations on recruitment, selection and appointment of police personnel shall be dealt with under existing rules and regulations.


