**RESOLUTION NO.** 2020-0133

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR MAGNETIC RESONANCE IMAGING (MRI) MACHINE**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, Paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, Sub-Paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor;”

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the Philippine National Police (PNP) submitted and recommended to the Commission, for consideration and approval, through its Technical Working Group (TWG) Resolution No. 2019-17 dated October 21, 2019, the proposed Minimum Standards for Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine;

**WHEREAS**, the PNP TWG proposed minimum standards refer to a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Machine which is a medical imaging technique used in radiology to form pictures of the anatomy and the physiological processes of the body;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for MRI Machine are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine, to read as follows:

<b>Particular</b>	<b>Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine</b>
1. Description	A medical equipment that uses a strong magnetic field and radio waves to create detailed images of the organs and tissues within the body on a movable bed.
2. Equipment capability	a) Electro-magnetic field strength
	b) Magnetic Coil that can be used as a detector which is applied directly to a body part for high resolution imaging; often a single loop of metal.

Particular	Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine
	c) With Cooling System
	d) High Resolution Images and hard copy
	e) For Clinical application


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications for the Magnetic Resonance Imaging Machine, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the said specifications comply and conform with the aforementioned minimum standards, RA 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and are advantageous to the PNP.
