RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0152

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR REFRIGERATED CENTRIFUGE

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms, and after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019 defines the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through its endorsement letter dated November 18, 2019, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission the proposed minimum standards for Refrigerated Centrifuge;

WHEREAS, the minimum standards for Refrigerated Centrifuge refer to a clinical laboratory equipment that is used to separate temperature sensitive samples like blood and its component from whole blood. It separates platelet, plasma, red blood cells, and cryoprecipitate from whole blood to produce a specific blood component which a patient needs for transfusion;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for Refrigerated Centrifuge is in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission;


NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Refrigerated Centrifuge, to read as follows:

Particular	Minimum Standards
1. Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Has a compressor with associated components in its chambers; b. Has safety shield which can be switch its power and brakes; and c. Has timer, potentiometer, tachometer, processor control and display.
2. Usage	Separates blood components from whole blood to produce a specific component by spinning very strong.
3. Capability	Can achieve user controlled in high speeds of centrifugal force that will cause blood components to

	separate at user-determined temperature. Less maintenance needed in its continuous use.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specification of the Refrigerated Centrifuge, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the said specification conforms with the minimum standards and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."


