



**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0410**

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR PNP PATROL SHIRT**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through the PNP Technical Working Group for the Formulation and Amendment of Standards (TWG-FAS) Resolution No. 2020-01, dated January 14, 2020, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission on the proposed minimum standards for PNP Patrol Shirt;

**WHEREAS**, the proposed minimum standards refer to the utilization of Patrol Shirt as the upper garment of the PNP Patrol uniform in lieu of the GOA Type “C” uniform, which is considered to be more functional and comfortable when performing patrol duties;

**WHEREAS**, there is an existing approved minimum standard specifications for PNP Patrol Shirt embodied under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2009-717, dated December 28, 2009, which needs to be amended because the material/finished product is no longer available in the market and the 100% cotton fabric material exhibits formation of pills, fades easily, and shrinks/elongates when washed and worn overtime;

**WHEREAS**, the issue on the availability and quality of material of the existing PNP Patrol Shirt was amended by changing the composition of the material, the color shade (due to change in material composition), and the mode of production/attachment of the badge, patches, and the word “PULIS”;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for PNP Patrol Shirt is in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBED, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for PNP Patrol Shirt”, to read as follows:


**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications for the PNP Patrol Shirt which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the same comply, conform and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and are advantageous to the PNP.

**BE IT RESOLVED FURTHER**, that NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2009-717 dated December 28, 2009, entitled "Prescribing the Standard Specifications for PNP Patrol Shirt" is hereby repealed.
