



RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0414

PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR PNP PATROL VEHICLE

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms, and after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002, dated January 29, 2019, defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforesaid legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through its Technical Working Group for the Formulation and Amendment of Standards (TWG-FAS) Resolution No. 2020-06, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission on the proposed minimum standards for PNP Patrol Vehicle;

WHEREAS, the minimum standards for PNP Patrol Vehicle is a collective term referring to any, but not limited to, Patrol Car, Patrol Jeep, Light Transport Vehicle and Pick-up Vehicle to support the needs of the PNP in its mandated mission and function such as peace and order and law enforcement. The PNP Patrol Vehicle will be used for patrolling, ferrying personnel and equipment during operations;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for PNP Patrol Vehicle is in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for PNP Patrol Vehicle, to read as follows:

Particulars	Minimum Standards
1) Type	PNP Patrol Vehicle
2) Description	A four-wheeled vehicle with appropriate markings, police blinker and PA System
3) Capability	a. Can accommodate at least four (4) personnel. b. With appropriate suspension for carrying its load capacity. c. Can Travel elevated/mountainous road or any terrain as required. d. Can operate for 1,500 kilometers without turning off the engine.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications for the PNP Patrol Vehicle, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the


said specifications conform with the minimum standards and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."
