**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0418**

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR  
ENDOSCOPY CAMERA SYSTEM WITH TOWER**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms, and after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

**WHEREAS**, the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019 defines the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through PNP TWG-FAS Resolution No. 2019-015 dated October 21, 2019, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission the proposed Minimum Standards for Endoscopy Camera System with Tower;

**WHEREAS**, the minimum standards for Endoscopy Camera System with Tower refer to an equipment used to investigate symptoms in the digestive system including nausea, vomiting, abdominal pain, difficulty in swallowing, gastrointestinal bleeding and conduct procedures that may involve the taking of biopsies, dilations, retrieval of foreign objects and removal of stones from the bile duct;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation of the herein proposed Resolution on the minimum standards for Endoscopy Camera System with Tower, the Commission has determined that it is in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, hence, in order.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission, in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Endoscopy Camera System with Tower, to wit:

Particular	Minimum Standards
Description	A long, thin illuminated flexible tube that has lens at one end and a fiber optic camera at the other which allows magnification of an image to be projected onto a video screen to view and record the inside of the body and examine the interior of a hollow organ or cavity for diagnostic or therapeutic purposes.
Usage	Illuminates the true-color, brilliance of image, brightness and contrast of healthy tissue from tissue requiring treatment through the use of light source.

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
Particular	Minimum Standards
Capabilities	Processes digital High Definition (HD) images, Camera Control Unit (CCU) down-convert HD signals to Standard Definition (SD) signals to HD.
	Provides spacious display formats and improved color reproduction of new picture-by-picture capability.
	Has high level of light source fiber optic.
	Provides High Definition monitor.
	With digital recording system.
	With trolley video endoscopy.
	Provided with telescope instruments
	With stroboscope generator for vocal cords, including microphone, footswitch and all the cables

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specification of the Endoscopy Camera System with Tower, which will be the basis for its procurement, and ensure that the said specification conforms with the minimum standards and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act."
