**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-0420**

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR DEEP DIVE VIDEO CAMERA**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms, and after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

**WHEREAS**, the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019 defines the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP)

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through its endorsement letter dated February 04, 2020, requested for consideration/approval of the Commission on the proposed minimum standards for Deep Dive Video Camera;

**WHEREAS**, the minimum standards for Deep Dive Video Camera refers to an electronic device that can be used for scuba or deep diving and capable to record videos or capture images and photos underwater; document dive activities during rescue, operative, and tactical operations; and enhance the tactical and operational capability of the PNP;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for Deep Dive Video Camera is in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Deep Dive Video Camera, to read as follows:

Particulars	Minimum Standards
1) Equipment Type	Underwater Electronic Video Camera.
2) Description	A rugged and waterproof video camera capable of recording and capturing images with excellent resolution underneath the water. The video camera has a Wi-Fi connection and storage data card.
3) Equipment Capability	Has a minimum two hours operating capability and at least 100m operating depth covering all diving conditions.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specification of the Refrigerated Centrifuge, which will be the basis for its procurement and ensure that the said specification conforms with the minimum standards and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act.”


