**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0079**

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARDS FOR  
RADIANT WARMER**

**WHEREAS**, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to "approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention, and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards, and medals of honor";

**WHEREAS**, the NAPOLCOM Memorandum Circular No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019, defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment to be procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the aforementioned legal prescription, the PNP Director, Directorate for Research and Development, through its endorsement letter dated December 09, 2021, requested for consideration and approval by the Commission on the minimum standards for Radiant Warmer;

**WHEREAS**, the minimum standards for Radiant Warmer refer to a medical equipment consisting of a tray with a biocompatible bed and an overhead heater used for treatment and prevention of hypothermia in neonates requiring thermal care;

**WHEREAS**, the minimum standards for Radiant Warmer were determined to be with performance-based criteria and parameters that are appropriate and fit to the intended use, purpose and objective to be acquired or procured by the PNP;

**WHEREAS**, upon thorough review and evaluation, the Commission has determined that the herein proposed minimum standards for Radiant Warmer are in order and conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic

Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), logistics policies and issuances of the Commission, to meet the requirements of the PNP;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory powers to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the Minimum Standards for Radiant Warmer, to read as follows:

Particulars	Standards
1. Description	An electrically powered and movable device which consists of a tray with a biocompatible bed, provided with an artificial heating mechanism mounted overhead and with an Intravenous (IV) Pole.
2. Capability	a) Provides stable temperature for patient-infants or neonates requiring thermal care.
	b) Provides uniform heating across the bed as well as faster warmup time that reduces the time to warm a hypothermic infant.
	c) Signals audible and/or visible alarms.

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specification for Radiant Warmer, which will be the basis for its procurement, and ensure that the said specification complies, conforms, and is within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act, and are advantageous to the PNP.

**RESOLVED FURTHERMORE**, that any other existing issuances inconsistent with this resolution are hereby **repealed** or **rescinded**.
