RESOLUTION NO. 2022-0080

**PRESCRIBING THE MINIMUM STANDARD DESIGN FOR
PNP COMMAND DIRECTORY**

WHEREAS, Section 14, paragraphs (i) and (m) of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Section 5, paragraph (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8) of the Republic Act No. 8551, empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention, and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards, and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, on December 8, 2010, the Commission issued Memorandum Circular (MC) No. 2010-005 directing the Chief, Philippine National Police to require all Police Stations to put up a directory/list of names of organic PNP personnel at entrances of all Police Stations nationwide:

WHEREAS, NAPOLCOM MC No. 2019-002 dated January 29, 2019, defined the duty and authority of the NAPOLCOM to prescribe minimum standards for uniforms, arms, and equipment that are germane and fit to the intended use, purpose, and objective of the items to be acquired or procured by the Philippine National Police (PNP);

WHEREAS, the PNP through the Directorate for Research and Development (DRD) endorsed to the Commission the approved Technical Working Group for the Formulation and Amendment of Standards (TWG-FAS) Resolution No. 2021-12-030 dated December 9, 2021, on the proposed minimum standard for PNP Command Directory with attached documentary requirements, for consideration and approval;

WHEREAS, the proposed minimum standard design for Command Directory refer to information, signage panels showing the list of names of PNP units/offices, organic

PNP officers/personnel and its designations to be installed and displayed at the entrance of each PNP office's/unit's building;

WHEREAS, upon thorough review and evaluation of the minimum standards and pertinent documents submitted by the PNP, the Commission finds the same to be in order and to conform with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR), all existing policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO PRESCRIBE, AS IT HEREBY PRESCRIBES**, the minimum standard design for PNP Command Directory, to read as follows:

- a. Design/Construction - Visible information custom-made directory with a braced frame structure
- b. Content - PNP, Regional, Provincial, unit offices, names of Command group and organic staff/key officers and its designation with PNP logo and seal

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PNP shall formulate the technical specifications for the design of the PNP Command Directory which will be the basis for its procurement, and shall ensure that the same comply, conform, and are within the aforementioned minimum standards, and pertinent provisions of the Republic Act No. 9184, otherwise known as the Government Procurement Reform Act and are advantageous to the PNP.

RESOLVED FURTHERMORE, that any other existing issuances inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed or rescinded.
