INVITATION TO BID FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF SECURITY SERVICES

- 1. The NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION, through the general appropriations intends to apply the amount of Nine Million Four Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Pesos (P9,429,000.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the procurement of Security Services. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
- 2. The NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION now invites bids for the abovementioned procurement project. Delivery of Goods is required within thirty (30) days upon receipt of Notice to Proceed. The Bidders should have completed, within five (5) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible Bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly in Section II, Instruction to Bidders.
- 3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act." Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.
- 4. Interested Bidders may obtain further information from the NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders starting on May 28, 2019 from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Ten Thousand Pesos (P10,000.00).
 - It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.
- 6. The NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION will hold a Pre-bid Conference on June 4, 2019 at 1:30 p.m. at the NAPOLCOM Conference Room, 18th Floor, DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, NAPOLCOM Building, EDSA corner Quezon Avenue, West Triangle, Quezon City which shall be open to prospective bidders.

7. Bids must be duly received by the NBAC Secretariat at the address below on or before 1:30 p.m. of June 18, 2019. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the applicable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

Bid opening shall be on June 18, 2019, 1:30 p.m. at the NAPOLCOM Conference Room, 18th Floor, DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, NAPOLCOM Building, EDSA corner Quezon Avenue, West Triangle, Quezon City. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.

- 8. The NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION reserves the right to reject any and all bids, to declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
