



PNP ENTRANCE AND PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS ANNOUNCEMENT

The National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM), pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the Philippine National Police (PNP), will conduct the **Police Executive Service Eligibility-Written Examination (PESE-WE)** on April 26, 2025, and the **PNP Entrance (PNPE)** and **Promotional Examinations (PROMEX)** on April 27, 2025.

The PESE Process has two (2) phases – PHASE I is the WRITTEN EXAMINATION to be administered in Quezon City, Cebu City and Davao City. PHASE II is the VALIDATION INTERVIEW for those who passed the Written Examination and previous Written Examination passers, the schedule of which shall be announced after the release of the results of the Written Examination. Those who passed the PESE Process (Phase I and Phase II) shall be conferred the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE) which is a requirement for promotion to third level ranks of Police Colonel, Police Brigadier General, Police Major General, Police Lieutenant General, and Police General in the PNP.

The PNPE Examination is open to all Filipino citizens who meet the age and educational requirements provided hereunder and to Patrolmen/Patrolwomen with temporary status of appointment due to lack of appropriate eligibility. Examinees who pass the PNPE Examination are conferred with police eligibility, which is required for appointment to the rank of Patrolman/Patrolwoman. On the other hand, the PNP PROMEX is exclusive to all qualified uniformed personnel of the Philippine National Police (PNP) who meet the minimum qualification standards specified herein for the examinations in terms of rank and eligibility. Examinees who pass the PROMEX are conferred with police eligibilities required for promotion to the ranks corresponding to the examination's Eligibility Rank Coverage (ERC).

The following are the guidelines and procedures for the PESE-WE, and PNPE and PROMEX on April 26-27, 2025, respectively:

VII. PESE-WE APPLICATION PROCEDURE

An applicant must submit his/her application with the following required documents personally at any of the 17 NAPOLCOM Regional Offices, indicating his/her choice of examination center, i.e., Quezon City, Cebu City or Davao City:

- A. Properly accomplished Examination Application form and Index Card (*to be provided by the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where the applicant wishes to file*);
- B. PNP ID;
- C. Two (2) colored recent passport size photo (in PNP uniform with white background) with name tag (*rank, first, middle, and last names*); and,
- D. Examination fee: Seven Hundred Pesos (*Php P700.00*).

NOTE: AN APPLICANT MUST FILE ONLY ONE (1) application and MUST be filed on or before the deadline for filing. Application Form and Index Card may be REPRODUCED using the original copy and size of the documents.

VIII. PNPE and PROMEX ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

All applicants for the PNP Entrance and Promotional Examinations should register to the NAPOLCOM Online Scheduling System prior to the processing of his/her application by following the procedures below:

- A. Go to NAPOLCOM website **www.napolcom.gov.ph**;
- B. Click the NAPOLCOM Online Scheduling System link;
- C. Fill out the required data and review the same;
- D. Upload:
 1. For Civilian applicant - One (1) valid government-issued I.D. with applicant's date of birth (*National, Passport, Postal, Driver's License, etc.*).
 2. For PNP member - PNP ID.
- E. Receive a **Notice** indicating the date of the on-site processing of his/her application at the Regional Office concerned and have the same screened shot/printed.

IX. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Applicants with a confirmed processing schedule should proceed to the Regional Office for the processing of his/her application, including the filling out of the Examination Application Form and Index Card (*to be provided by the Regional Office*) with the following requirements:

2. Two (2) colored recent passport size photo (in white shirt and white background) with name tag (*first, middle, and last names*);
3. One (1) valid government-issued ID with applicant's date of birth (*National, Passport, Postal, Driver's License, etc.*);

4. Photocopy (present the original) or Certified Xerox Copy of **ANY** of the following:
 - a. Transcript of Records
 - b. Diploma
 - c. Certificate of Graduation
5. One (1) legal-size window envelope with Twenty-One Pesos (PhP21.00) worth of mailing stamp; and,
6. Exam Fee: Four Hundred Pesos (PhP400.00).

B. PNPE Exam (Patrolman/Patrolwoman with Temporary Status of Appointment)

IMPORTANT

APPLICANT MUST BE AT THE NAPOLCOM REGIONAL OFFICE ON HIS/HER SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT DATE WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS.

X. DOCUMENTS/ITEMS TO BRING DURING THE EXAMINATION

- A. Printed Notice of Admission (NOA) issued by the Regional Office;
- B. Identification Card:
 1. For Civilian applicant - One (1) valid government-issued I.D. with applicant's date of birth (*National, Passport, Postal, Driver's License, etc.*)

- D. Black or blue ball pen (*For PESE-WE, PO 1st and PO 2nd Classes examinees only*).

NOTE: Only examinees with printed NOA shall be authorized to take the exam. Clearances issued by the Barangay, PNP, NBI, Court shall not be accepted as valid government-issued ID.

XI. EXAMINATION ATTIRE

- A. PESE-WE examinees must be in GOA TYPE A.
- B. PNPE examinees are required to wear a white shirt, shoes, and black/dark blue pants (*maong/slacks*). Examinees are advised to observe proper grooming.
- C. PROMEX examinees shall wear their PNP GOA Type C. The Examination Administrator may authorize the wearing of PNP Patrol Shirt or Field Service Uniform (*green/pixelized camouflage*) for justifiable/ exceptional reasons.

NOTE: Examinees not in the prescribed attire shall NOT be allowed to enter the examination venue.

XIII. PROHIBITIONS, VIOLATIONS AND SANCTIONS

- A. The examination results of examinees involved in acts of cheating such as, but not limited to herein below, shall be invalidated and the examinees above shall be permanently barred from taking the examinations¹³:
 1. Impersonation;
 2. Use of codigo or crib sheets;
 3. Tampering with examination records;

4. Collusion of whatever nature between examinees and examination personnel;
5. Test booklet switching; and
6. Such other acts of a similar nature that facilitate the passing of the examination.

NOTE: Examinees who are caught committing acts of cheating, as enumerated above, shall be permanently barred from taking the NAPOLCOM examinations.

- B. Police Officers who are found to have committed the anomalous acts, as enumerated above, shall not only be permanently barred from taking the examination but shall also be charged with dishonesty and, if found culpable, shall be meted the penalty of dismissal from the service¹⁴.
- C. Individuals found to have used fake NAPOLCOM eligibility for their entry into the police service shall likewise be permanently barred from taking the NAPOLCOM examinations and shall be filed with appropriate charges¹⁵.
- D. If it will be established that such anomalous practices were committed in collusion with or due to gross negligence of the proctors, examiners, supervisors, and other officials and persons assigned or otherwise involved in the preparation for the administration of the examinations, they shall likewise be criminally or administratively held liable by law and the Civil Service Rules and Regulations¹⁶.
- E. Police Service Eligibility obtained through anomalous practices shall be nullified.
- F. Bringing in any of the following inside the examination center is strictly prohibited and shall automatically disqualify an examinee from taking the examination or shall result in the nullification of the same¹⁷.
 1. Firearm
 2. Explosive or any deadly weapon
 3. Two-way radio
 4. Cellular phone or any electronic gadget
 5. Calculator
 6. Smartwatches
 7. Review/Reading materials
- G. Bringing of the following is also prohibited:
 1. Bags and Knapsacks
 2. Other things/objects unnecessary to the examination.

XIV. NOTIFICATION OF EXAMINATION RESULTS

Results of the Police Executive Service Eligibility-Written Examination shall be posted at the NAPOLCOM website. Examinees who will pass the PESE-WE shall be qualified to undergo the PESE-Validation Interview (PESE-VI). The

date, time and place of interview shall be officially announced by the Commission.

The nationwide list of the PNPE and PROMEX Successful Examinees will be posted at the NAPOLCOM One-Stop-Shop (NOSS), 7th Floor, DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, NAPOLCOM Building, Quezon City and the NAPOLCOM's website. A regional list will also be posted in all NAPOLCOM Regional Offices.

To facilitate/ensure the efficient distribution and timely receipt of the examination results by the PNPE and PROMEX examinees, the Certificates of Eligibility (*for successful examinees*) or the Reports of Rating (*for failed examinees*) shall be issued/sent by the Central Office to the Regional Offices for mailing to the examinees using the legal-size window envelope with Twenty-One Pesos (PhP21.00) worth of mailing stamp submitted/provided by the examinee during the application.

PNPE and PROMEX passers who did not receive their Certificate of Eligibility may request for the issuance of a Certification from the NAPOLCOM Central and Regional Offices, upon payment of One Hundred Fifty Pesos (PhP150.00). For requests sent through postal mail or courier service, payment shall be in money order form payable to the National Police Commission.

XV. CONFIDENTIALITY NOTICE

It is understood that all data and documents provided and uploaded during the online registration including information contained in the submitted required documents are considered true and correct and shall be treated as official data.
