The **PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS** are **OPEN EXCLUSIVELY TO ALL QUALIFIED UNIFORMED MEMBERS OF THE PNP** who meet the minimum qualification standards for examination in terms of rank and eligibility as provided herein.

Those who passed the PNP Promotional Examinations are conferred Promotional Eligibilities appropriate for promotion to the ranks corresponding to the examination's Eligibility Rank Coverage (ERC). The eligibilities acquired through the Promotional Examinations are those required for promotion of PNP uniformed personnel, as prescribed under Sec. 30 of Republic Act No. 6975, as amended by Republic Act No. 8551.

5. HOW TO GET AN APPOINTMENT SCHEDULE FOR FILING OF APPLICATION TO TAKE THE PNP PROMOTIONAL EXAMINATIONS:

- A. Applicant logs in the NAPOLCOM official website <https://napolcom.gov.ph>, clicks on the ON-LINE EXAMINATION APPLICATION SCHEDULING SYSTEM or directly logs in to www.oleass-napolcom.com and fill outs the mandatory fields, as follows:
 - a. Examination Title
 - b. Present Rank
 - c. Last Name
 - d. First Name
 - e. Extension Name (Jr., Sr., I, II, III, etc.)
 - f. Middle Name
 - g. Email Address
 - h. Cellphone No.
 - i. Date of Birth
 - j. Unit of Assignment
- B. Applicant clicks SUBMIT after filling out the mandatory fields. A CONFIRMATION will appear if registration was successful. If not, the process should be repeated.
- C. Applicant clicks the PRINT CONFIRMATION LETTER button displayed on the screen to print his/her Confirmation Letter which will reflect the applicant's Examination Center, Examination Title, Schedule, Reference No., Place of Processing,

Requirements and the date to access and fill-out the on-line examination application form thru the Query Module of the OLEASS; and

- D. Applicant with confirmed schedule shall be sent an auto-generated email wherein they shall be required to access the online-link to enter all the required information in the application form. The filled-out application form shall be presented by the applicant to the Regional Office during his/her scheduled appointment date together with the confirmation schedule.

NOTE: The OLEASS shall allow the PNP Promotional examination applicant the option to choose the examination center where he/she wishes to take said examination, **regardless of place of residence.**

IMPORTANT

APPLICANT MUST BE AT THE NAPOLCOM REGIONAL OFFICE ON HIS/HER SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT DATE WITH ALL THE REQUIREMENTS

6. WHERE TO GET APPLICATION FORM AND INDEX CARD:

Application Form (PAS-QFM-QOP15-02) and Index Card can be obtained for **FREE** at any NAPOLCOM Regional Office nationwide, or may be downloaded from the NAPOLCOM website at <https://napolcom.gov.ph>. These may also be **REPRODUCED** using the original size of the Application Form and Index Card.

7. HOW TO FILE AN APPLICATION:

An applicant should present his/her printed-out application form, together with all the required supporting documents, on his/her scheduled appointment **PERSONALLY** only at the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where he/she will take the examination. **APPLICATIONS RECEIVED THRU POSTAL MAIL SHALL NOT BE PROCESSED.**

8. WHAT TO BRING WHEN FILING:

- A. Printed letter-reply with corresponding reference number confirming the scheduled appointment;
- B. Printed Filled-out Application Form (PAS-QFM-QOP15-02);
- C. Index Card, duly accomplished by the applicant;
- D. Two (2) recent and identical 1" x 1" ID pictures (in color) with white background and complete name tag (indicate rank before the first, middle and last name);
- E. **Police Examination Fees:**
 - a. Four Hundred Pesos (P400.00) for Police Officer 4th Class Exam.
 - b. Four Hundred Fifty Pesos (P450.00) for Police Officer 3rd Class Exam.
 - c. Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) for Police Officer 2nd Class Exam.
 - d. Six Hundred Pesos (P600.00) for Police Officer 1st Class Exam.

NO OTHER FEES SHALL BE COLLECTED

- F. One (1) legal-size window envelope and Twenty-one (21) pesos worth of stamp;
- G. Certified True Copy of Attested Appointment, Plantilla Appointment or PNP Absorption Order;
- H. Certificate of Eligibility/Certification issued by the NAPOLCOM Central Office, CSC Certificate of Eligibility or PRC Board Certificate; and
- I. One (1) Government issued ID with signature (SSS, GSIS, Voter's, Postal, Passport, Driver's License, PRC, etc.) **STRICTLY "NO I.D, NO PROCESSING"**.

An examinee who fails in an examination, or after being admitted to take said examination, fails to take it for one reason or another, **need not resubmit the requirements** in the event he/she applies to take the same examination in the same examination center. In such cases, the applicant will only have to:

- I. submit the ADMISSION SLIP of the last examination applied for;
- II. fill out a new application form and index card with ID pictures; and
- III. pay the examination fee.

9. NOTIFICATION OF EXAMINATION:

A qualified applicant shall be issued a Notice of Admission on the day he/she files his/her application for the examination. However, to confirm the status of said application, he/she may verify from the NAPOLCOM Regional Office where said application was filed.

10. EXAMINATION COVERAGE:

The three-hour examination consists of objective-type/multiple choice items for Police Officer 4th Class examination and Police Officer 3rd Class examinations, Police Officer 2nd Class examination and Police Officer 1st Class examinations. The following constitute the subject coverage:

11. WHAT TO WEAR ON EXAMINATION DAY:

FIELD SERVICE UNIFORM (FSU) OR PNP GOA B. Examinees not in the prescribed attire will not be allowed to enter the Examination Center

12. WHAT TO BRING DURING THE EXAMINATION:

- A. Notice of Admission (NOA);
- B. Pencil No. 2 and black ballpen (for Essay test);
- C. One (1) Government issued ID with signature (SSS, GSIS, Voter's, Postal, Passport, Driver's License, PRC, etc.). **STRICTLY "NO I.D, NO EXAMINATION";**
- D. All examinees must fill up their **Health Declaration Form/NAPOLCOM Telehealth QR Code** to be presented at the entrance of testing centers and must present **ANY** of the following:
 - a. **Vaccination Card** (for fully vaccinated individuals) **AND** a **Medical Certificate** issued by:
 - i. Licensed Private Physician; **OR**
 - ii. Government Physician from Barangay/Municipal/City/Provincial Health Office or any other government health monitoring center/office, clearly stating that examinee did not exhibit any signs or symptoms related to Covid-19 infection such as fever, cough, colds, shortness of breath or difficulty of breathing, chills, body aches, sore throat, headache, diarrhea,

- rashes, loss of sense of taste or smell at the time of examination and was asymptomatic for the past fourteen (14) days and not included in the list of SUSPECT (PUI), PROBABLE (PUM) nor CONFIRMED (Covid-19) patient. Said Medical Certificate must be issued within 72 hours before the examination day. In the event that the examinee acquired Covid-19 in the past, an additional Medical Certificate is warranted stating that the latter has already recovered from the disease and a Community Quarantine Certificate indicating that he/she has completed the fourteen (14) days quarantine, **OR**
- b. **Negative Reverse Transcriptase Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR) Test Result** (for non-fully vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals), issued within 72 hours before the examination day (from any government or government-accredited testing centers); **OR**
 - c. **Negative Covid-19 Antigen Test Result** (for non-fully vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals), issued within 72 hours before the examination day (from any government or government-accredited testing centers); **AND**
 - d. **Any other requirements as may be required by the LGU in their testing center** (if any).

13. PROHIBITIONS:

Bringing in of any of the following inside the testing center is **STRICTLY PROHIBITED**.

- A. Firearm, explosive or any deadly weapon
- B. Pager, any two-way radio or any electronic gadget (**bringing of cellular phone is allowed for purposes of QR Code scanning**)
- C. Review material
- D. Calculator

VIOLATION OF THIS RULE SHALL AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFY AN EXAMINEE FROM TAKING THE EXAMINATION AND SHALL RESULT IN THE NULLIFICATION OF HIS/HER EXAMINATION

14. NOTIFICATION OF RESULTS:

- A. The nationwide List of Successful Examinees will be posted at the NAPOLCOM Central Office located at DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, NAPOLCOM Building, EDSA corner Quezon Avenue, West Triangle, Quezon City 1104 and at the NAPOLCOM website. Similarly, a Regional List will be posted in each of the NAPOLCOM Regional Offices.

For inquiries, examinees may log in the NAPOLCOM web address at **www.napolcom.gov.ph**.

- B. Examination Results - Report of Rating (failed examinees) and Certificate of Eligibility (successful examinees) will be mailed to the examinee's mailing address. An examinee who passed the test but did not receive his/her Certificate of Eligibility may request for the issuance of a certification from the NAPOLCOM Regional or Central Office, upon payment of **One Hundred Fifty Pesos (₱150.00)**. For requests sent through postal mail, payment shall be in money order form payable to the National Police Commission, DILG-NAPOLCOM Center, NAPOLCOM Building, EDSA corner Quezon Avenue, West Triangle, Quezon City 1104.

15. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

It is understood that all data written by the applicant on the Application Form and Index Card, including information contained in the required submitted documents are considered **TRUE AND CORRECT** and shall be treated as official data. **AN APPLICANT'S QUALIFICATIONS ARE SUBJECT TO FINAL REVIEW AND VERIFICATION BY THE EXAMINING DIVISION, PERSONNEL AND ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICE (PAS), NAPOLCOM CENTRAL OFFICE.** AN APPLICANT MAY BE REQUIRED TO PRESENT ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS, IF DEEMED NECESSARY. THE TEST RESULT OF AN EXAMINEE SHALL BE CANCELLED/INVALIDATED IF IT IS ESTABLISHED THAT HE/SHE DOES NOT QUALIFY FOR THE EXAMINATION.

THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION HAS A COMPUTER SYSTEM THAT KEEPS TRACK OF THE ANSWER PATTERNS OF EXAMINEES. IF TWO OR MORE EXAMINEES HAVE A HIGH PERCENTAGE OF **SIMILAR ANSWER PATTERNS**, THIS SHALL RESULT IN THE INVALIDATION OF THEIR TEST RESULTS.

WARNING

- A. The examination results of examinees involved in **acts of cheating** such as, but not limited to the following, shall be invalidated:
- a. Impersonation;
 - b. Use of codigo or crib sheets;
 - c. Tampering with exam records;
 - d. Collusion of whatever nature between examinees and examination personnel;
 - e. Examination number switching;
 - f. Such other acts of similar nature that facilitate the passing of examination; and
 - g. Results declared by the Commission, thru Examination Division, PAS, as statistically improbable.

The aforesaid examinees shall be permanently barred from taking the NAPOLCOM Examinations.

- B. In the event that these anomalous acts were committed by a police officer, he/she shall be charged with **dishonesty**, and if found guilty, be meted the penalty of **dismissal from the service**.
- C. Individuals who are found to have used **fake NAPOLCOM eligibility** for their entry into the police service shall likewise be **permanently barred** from taking the NAPOLCOM examinations.
- D. Police service eligibility obtained through anomalous practices shall be **nullified**.

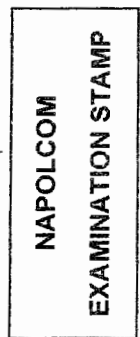
