RE : SILG DIRECTIVES

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Regularizing - 145

There are still a number of concerns and programs that require our full attention and sustained action this year and beyond, if necessary. The credibility of the DILG-PNP and the government to a large extent, is hinged on the quality of the performance that will be turned in.

Regularizing - PRS

Our flagship projects, namely "Pagbabago" and "Paglalansag" must be well managed to assure professionalism within the uniformed services of the DILG, and a peaceful and orderly social environment for all Filipinos.

"Pagbabago" should net much more swiftly the scalawags in uniform who must be properly charged administratively and/or criminally in the interest of justice and public service. "Paglalansag" must continually reduce the force of arms of private armed groups still in existence, be they dormant or active. More importantly, illicit economic activities to include illegal gambling, fishing and logging; drug trafficking; and other major vices must be effectively curtailed to cut-off the financial sustenance of these groups. The submission of weekly up-dates on the progress of both flagship projects must continue until further notice.

I would like to see, further, concrete efforts that will impact on the well-being of our personnel and their dependents starting this year. In particular, project proposals for housing, health care, educational support, and livelihood opportunities must be submitted for consideration within the month of March. Enough time has lapsed conceptualizing these morale-welfare programs. It is time for decision-making.

Perhaps the budget cut of almost P 700 million was a blessing for this will only mean an acceleration of the networking process. I would like to see a rapid expansion of our linkages or partnerships with the Community, the fifth pillar in the Criminal Justice System. In doing so, let us focus on crime prevention, fire safety, criminalistics, jail reforms and internal administration to boost our capabilities.


There are private organizations who are willing to lend a hand and possessing the needed expertise to offset what the budget cuts prevent us from acquiring in terms of human resources, operational effectiveness, and equipment. Let us turn a disadvantage into a distinct advantage by going direct to the people and forging a strong bond against crime and disorder. In addition, we must take into consideration as well, the new directions which emerged during the Peace and Order Summit last February 15-16 in Camp Crame.


In this regard, submit a list of organizations that we wish to link up with this year at the soonest possible time but not later than 15 March 1994.

For this purpose I am calling for a series of coordinating conferences on March 8, 15, 22 and 29 to set all these in place. Time and venue to be announced later. → PLS
