



MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT : RESULT OF NAPOLCOM SPECIAL QUALIFYING ELIGIBILITY (NSQE) EXAMINATION CONDUCTED ON MAY 29, 2022

DATE : JULY 11, 2022

1. Pursuant to Republic Act No. 11054, otherwise known as "An Act Providing for the Organic Law for the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao, Repealing for the Purpose Republic Act No. 6734, entitled "An Act Providing for An Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao," As Amended by Republic Act No. 9054, Entitled "An Act to Strengthen and Expand the Organic Act for the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao", specifically Section 2 thereof, provides that:

"To facilitate entry into the Philippine National Police of Moro Islamic Liberation Front and Moro National Liberation Front members from the Bangsamoro Autonomous Region, the age, height and educational attainment requirements may be waived by the National Police Commission, subject to existing rules and regulations: Provided, That such shall be availed of within a period of five (5) years from ratification of this Organic Law: Provided, further, That the requirement of educational attainment shall be complied within fifteen (15) years from their entry: Provided, finally, That their ranks and grades shall be subject to existing laws, rules and regulations governing the Philippine National Police".

2. In compliance with the above-mentioned law, the National Police Commission (NAPOLCOM) issued Resolution No. 2022-0081, entitled: "Prescribing NAPOLCOM Special Qualifying Eligibility (NSQE) as Appropriate Eligibility for Temporary Appointment to the Rank of Patrolman/Patrolwoman in The Philippine National Police (PNP) for Members of the Moro Islamic Liberation Front (MILF) and Moro National Liberation Front (MNLF)" which was approved on February 8, 2022.
3. Moreover, on May 29, 2022, the NAPOLCOM conducted the NSQE Examination in Cotabato City and Lamitan City, Basilan wherein 11,033 members of the MILF and MNLF took the examination. However, three examinees were disqualified.

Likewise, after the conduct of decoding by the key officials of the NAPOLCOM on July 10, 2022 of the aforesaid examination, a total of 7,145 or 64.77% MILF and MNLF members successfully passed.

4. In this regard, the Commission pursuant to its mandate as stated under Section 21 of Republic Act No. 8551, otherwise known as the "Philippine National Police Reform and Reorganization Act of 1998", provides that the National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examination for police officers on the basis of the standards set by the Commission, hereby publishes the 7,145 successful examinees whose names are attached herewith.
