RESOLUTION No. 2006-115

**AMENDING NAPOLCOM RESOLUTION NO. 2004-145 ENTITLED
“APPROVING THE STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR
HEMOSTATIC AGENT”**

WHEREAS, Section 14 paragraphs (a), sub-paragraphs (5) and (8), of Republic Act 6975 as amended by Section 5 of Republic Act 8551 empowers the Commission to “approve or modify plans and programs on education and training, logistical requirements, communications, records, information system, crime laboratory, crime prevention and crime reporting as well as prescribe minimum standards for arms, equipment and uniforms and, after consultation with the Philippine Heraldry Commission, for insignia of ranks, awards and medals of honor”;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the aforecited legal prescription, the PNP, through its Uniform and Equipment Standardization Board (UESB) Resolution No. 2005-32 has favorably submitted and indorsed the proposed amendment to the standard specifications for the Hemostatic Agent for consideration by the Commission;

WHEREAS, the standard specifications for the Hemostatic Agent under NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2004-145 is so bulky due to the additional accessories included therein which hinders the mobility of PNP SAF during operations;

WHEREAS, upon proper evaluation, the increase in the required weight of hemostatic agent per packet from *2.0 grams* to *3.5 ounces (99.22g)* would assure of having enough to treat any size of wound and can also treat multiple wounds on multiple victims if the wounds are not severe. As for the dressing and other accessories omitted, the *bandage* consolidates the function of numerous pieces of equipment thus, making the treatment more efficient;

WHEREAS, the Commission, after thorough consideration of the proposed amendment to the standard specifications for Hemostatic Agent, finds the same in order and in conformity with the requirements of Republic Act No. 6975 as amended by Republic Act No. 8551, its implementing rules and regulations (IRR), all related logistics policies and issuances of the Commission to meet the requirements of the PNP;

NOW THEREFORE, the Commission in the exercise of its statutory power to administer and control the PNP, **HAS RESOLVED TO AMEND AS IT HEREBY AMENDS** the prescribed standard specifications for the Hemostatic Agent, to read as follows:

I. DESCRIPTIONS

- Biological and botanically inert;
- Can be left in the wound until the soldier is extracted and transported to a medical facility;
- Easy to pack and easy to apply;

- Provides everything needed to immediately administer life-saving aid for a traumatic bleeding injury;
- Outer pack is waterproof; and
- Fits into standard Battle Dress Uniform (BDU) pockets.

II. SPECIFICATIONS


- Substance : Granular Hemostatic Agent with a minimum weight of 3.5 ounces (99.22 grams)
- Accessories : One (1) cinch tight compression bandage or equivalent
- 2 Two (2) packs of compressed gauze
- : Accessory pouch with "PNP" markings

III. WARRANTY : At least one (1) year warranty

IV. Must pass the PNP functional test and evaluation.

BE IT RESOLVED, that all other existing specifications which are inconsistent with these standard specifications for Hemostatic Agent are hereby repealed, amended or modified accordingly.


