RESOLUTION NO. 2007-077

**APPROVING THE EQUIVALENCE OF THE POLICE INTELLIGENCE COURSE (PIC) AND THE
CONSTABULARY/INTEGRATED BASIC INTELLIGENCE COURSE (CIBIC) WITH THE
PUBLIC SAFETY JUNIOR LEADERSHIP COURSE (PSJLC) FOR
PROMOTION/APPOINTMENT TO SPO2**

WHEREAS, on 26 March 2002, the NAPOLCOM issued the qualification standards for promotion to PNP ranks per Resolution No. 2002-034 entitled "AMENDING NAPOLCOM RESOLUTION NO. 97-218 AND IMPLEMENTING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 14, 21 AND 33 OF RA B551 EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY";

WHEREAS, in the said resolution, it is provided that the mandatory training for appointment/promotion to SPO2 is the Public Safety Junior Leadership Course, among others;


WHEREAS, in a letter to the Philippine Public Safety College (PPSC) dated 29 August 2006, the Commission sought for the grant of equivalence of the Police Intelligence Course (PIC) and, its precursor, the Constabulary/Integrated Basic Intelligence Course (CIBIC) with the PSJLC in view of the assertion of the DPRM that both training courses were inadvertently left out when NAPOLCOM Resolution No 2002-034 was issued;


WHEREAS, after reviewing the Programs of Instructions of the three courses and the competencies acquired from the completion thereof, the PPSC found the PIC and CIBIC identical with the PSJLC per PPSC Academic Board Resolution NO. 06-003 dated 7 November 2006;

WHEREAS, the Commission finds the recommendation of the PPSC valid and in order;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission, pursuant to its constitutional mandate to administer and control the PNP, HAS RESOLVED TO APPROVE, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVES TO APPROVE, the equivalence of the Police Intelligence Course (PIC) and the Constabulary/Integrated Basic Intelligence Course (CIBIC) with the Public Safety Junior Leadership Course (PSJLC) for promotion/appointment to SPO2.


