RESOLUTION NO. 2007 - 181

**REPEALING PARAGRAPH THREE (3) OF RESOLUTION No. 2005-408
ENTITLED "FURTHER AMENDING NAPOLCOM RESOLUTION NO. 2002-034 IN
RELATION TO THE APPROPRIATE TRAINING FOR APPOINTMENT/PROMOTION
FROM PO2 TO SPO1"**

WHEREAS, the Commission issued Resolution No. 2005-408 entitled "*Further Amending Napolcom Resolution No. 2002-034 in Relation to the Appropriate Training for Appointment/Promotion from PO2 to SPO1*";

WHEREAS, said Resolution provided for the incorporation of the Soldiers Candidate Course (SCC) and the Basic Military Course (BMC) into the list of trainings equivalent to the Public Safety Basic Recruit Course (PSBRC) in order to address the issue of Police Non-Commissioned Officers (PNCOs) particularly those holding the ranks of PO2 to SPO1 who were disqualified from promotion or were promoted in temporary status due to their lack of appropriate training such as the PSBRC;

WHEREAS, paragraph three (3) of the same Resolution provides that "*in addition to the AFP BRTC, the Philippine Public Safety College (PPSC) has issued several resolutions granting equivalence to the Narcotics Investigation Course (NIC), Traffic Investigation Course (TIC) and Crime Investigation and Detection Course (CRIDEC) with the PSBRC*";

WHEREAS, the PPSC clarified that under PPSC Board of Trustees Resolution No. 01 s 2003, the NIC, TIC and CRIDEC has a combined Course Accreditation/Equivalence of Public Safety Junior Leadership Course (PSJLC) and Public Safety Senior Leadership Course (PSSLC) but not PSBRC;

WHEREAS, the PSJLC and PSSLC are appropriate trainings for the ranks of SPO2 to SPO4 as provided for under Napolcom Resolution No. 2002-034;

WHEREAS, there is a need to repeal paragraph three (3) of Napolcom Resolution No. 2005-408 to avoid further confusion among PNCOs who are applying for promotion to the next higher;
