RESOLUTION NO. 2007-245

AUTHORIZING CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT EDGARDO E. ACUÑA OF THE DIRECTORATE FOR PERSONNEL AND RECORDS MANAGEMENT, PNP TO REQUEST AND RECEIVE FROM THE POLICE EXECUTIVE COMPETENCIES ASSESSMENT PACKAGE (PECAP) DESIGN TEAM ALL THE DOCUMENTS CONSISTING OF THE DELIVARABLES MENTIONED IN THE MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT DATED NOVEMBER 2, 2005 BETWEEN PECAP DESIGN TEAM REPRESENTED BY MR. ANTONIO R. NARCISO AND THE NATIONAL POLICE COMMISSION (NAPOLCOM) REPRESENTED BY THEN VICE CHAIR AND EXECUTIVE OFFICER IMELDA CRISOL-ROCES

WHEREAS, Section 32 of R.A. No. 6975, as amended , specifically provides that " [T]he National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examinations for policemen on the basis of the standards set by the Commission";

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court in G.R. No. 141732 dated April 17, stated, inter alia, that "it is the promotional examination administered by the National Police Commission which would entitle a police officer the appropriate eligibility for promotion...";

WHEREAS, pursuant to the said law and in line with the aforesaid Supreme Court decision, the National Police Commission entered into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) dated November 2, 2005 with a group of consultants composed of Cynthia C. Arcadio, Marietta D. Biliran, Rainer A. Ibane and Antonio R. Narciso, who were collectively organized as the PECAP Design Team;

WHEREAS, Title III of the said MOA provides for the Deliverables of the parties enumerated in pages two (2) to four (4) within the period of October 2005 to January 2007;

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2006, the Commission issued Resolution No. 2006-82 declaring the establishment of the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE) Examination in lieu of the Civil Service Executive Eligibility (CSEE) Examination,

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2006, the Commission issued Resolution No. 2006-224 declaring the result of the first PESE Examination conducted by the PECAP Team;

WHEREAS, despite the conduct of the PESE Examination, the expiration of the period of delivery, and the Commission's full compliance of all its obligations under the said MOA, the PECAP Design Team had failed to comply with its obligations under the MOA specifically on Title III thereof by failing to deliver to the Commission PECAP Assessment tools and norms and the PECAP Manual (Copyrighted)

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission has resolved as it hereby resolves that Chief Superintendent Edgardo E. Acuña of the Directorate for Personnel and Records Management, PNP, to request and receive from the PECAP Design Team, the PECAP Assessment Tools and Norms and the PECAP Manual (Copyrighted) which said Team failed to deliver as agreed upon in the memorandum dated November 2, 2005.


