RESOLUTION NO. 2010-085

**CONFERMENT OF POLICE EXECUTIVE SERVICE ELIGIBILITY (PESE) ON  
EDUARDO CASTRO ABADAY AND ONE HUNDRED FOUR (104) OTHERS**

**WHEREAS**, Section 23, of Republic Act No. 6975, otherwise known as the PNP Law of 1990, as amended by R.A. No. 8551, provides that the National Police Commission shall administer the entrance and promotional examinations for policemen on the basis of standards set by the Commission;

**WHEREAS**, Section 38 (a) of R.A. No. 6975, as amended by Section 33 of R.A. No. 8551, also provides that – "A uniformed member of the PNP shall not be eligible for promotion to a higher position unless he or she has successfully passed the corresponding promotional examination given by the Commission, or the Bar, or the corresponding board examinations for technical services and other professions,..."

**WHEREAS**, the Supreme Court ruled that "it is the promotional examination administered by the National Police Commission which would entitle a police officer to the appropriate eligibility for promotion" (G.R. No. 141732, April 17, 2001);

**WHEREAS**, the Commission issued Resolution No. 2006-082, prescribing the PESE as the eligibility requirement for Third Level ranks (Senior Superintendent and higher in the PNP);

**WHEREAS**, the National Police Commission conducted the third PESE Written Examination on August 30, 2009 in three major test centers: NCR for Luzon, Cebu City for Visayas and Davao City for Mindanao;

**WHEREAS**, NAPOLCOM Resolution No. 2009-542 declared the results of the aforesaid PESE Written Examination in which One Hundred Thirteen (113) out of Four Hundred Seventy Three (473) passed;

**WHEREAS**, on November 7-8, 2009 the Commission interviewed One Hundred Fifty Four (154) PNP Senior Officials consisting of One Hundred Nine (109) successful examinees and Forty Five (45) passers of the previous PESE written examination;

**WHEREAS**, the Commission allowed the interview of successful examinees of the written examinations in 2006, 2007 and 2008 who were not able to join or failed in the panel interview conducted during those years;

**WHEREAS**, One Hundred Five (105) out of the One Hundred Fifty Four (154) interviewees passed this final phase of the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE);


**NOW, THEREFORE**, the National Police Commission, by virtue of its constitutional mandate to administer and control the Philippine National Police, **HEREBY RESOLVES TO CONFER, AS IT HEREBY CONFERS**, the Police Executive Service Eligibility (PESE) on the One Hundred Five (105) successful examinees whose names are enumerated hereunder:

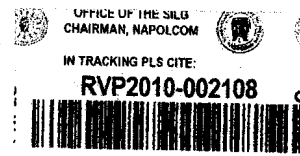
